During the October 4th hearing both petitioner and respondent agreed to have their dispute resolved at a peacemaking session on Wednesday, October 13, 2004 at 8AM. This matter was transferred to Peacemaking. The parties were informed that if agreement was reached they were to file the Agreement with the Clerk of Court. The trial court issued a stay under Rule 23(3) (a), Rules of Civil Procedure, allowing parties until November 18, 2004 to resolve this dispute through Peacemaking. The restraining order would remain in effect until the dispute is resolved in Peacemaking or until this case is resolved before the trial court, whichever comes first. On October 18, 2004 a copy of the Peacemaking Agreement was filed with the Clerk of Court. The Agreement shows that the parties did resolve their dispute. The injunction was lifted on October 18, 2004. The Agreement was honored, the matter is settled and no further proceedings are necessary. This matter is closed.
