Pre-Trial Order

The above-captioned case has come before the Oneida Appeals Commission Trial Court. Judicial Officers Anita Barber, Robert Christjohn and Leland Wigg-Ninham, presiding.

Background

On May 16, 2006, this matter came before the panel for a Pre-Trial conference pursuant to Rule 23 of the Oneida Appeals Commission Rules of Civil Procedure. The Petitioner appeared in person. Arlene Danforth appeared on behalf of Oneida HRD-Benefits and Jack Fleming appeared on behalf of Crawford Insurance. Petitioner appeals a denial of workers' compensation benefits by Respondents.

Decision

Under Rule 23, one of the purposes of the pre-trial conference is to consider any matters which will aid in the simplification, clarification, settlement or disposition of the case. After hearing a brief summary of each party's position, the Court has identified the following issues for trial:


1. Was Petitioner's harm caused by an injury arising out of his employment?

At trial, the panel expects witness testimony and documentary evidence presented by both parties to support their positions.

If the Petitioner wishes to proceed to a trial, he should notify the Court Clerk in writing by close of business Friday, June 16, 2006. If no notification is received, the matter will be dismissed.

It is so ordered.


