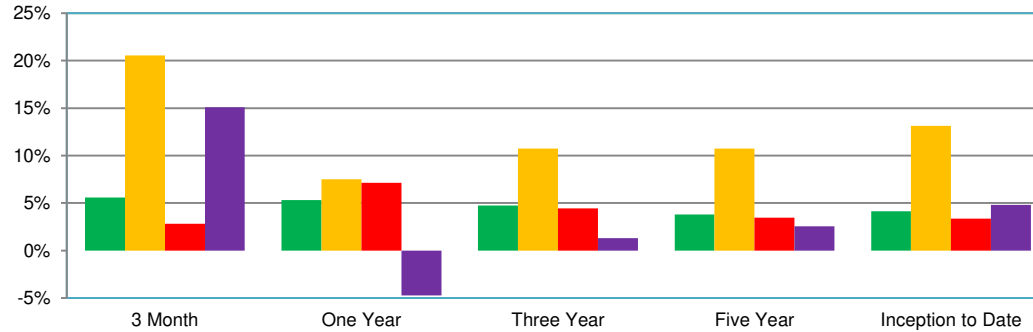
Investment Objective & Strategy

The Oneida Minors' Trust seeks to provide its beneficiaries with long-term competitive returns through a diversified portfolio of investments.

The Trust's portfolio is an actively managed, balanced portfolio of equity, fixed-income securities, and cash equivalents. Designed for preservation of capital the 15+ portfolio includes a higher allocation to bonds or fixed income and lower allocation to equities or stocks. It is assumed the beneficiaries in the 15+ portfolio will claim their trust benefits in 3 to 5 years. Under normal circumstances, the approximate percentage of each asset class in the portfolio will be 15% US Equities, 5% Non US Equities, 70% Fixed, and 10% Cash/Cash equivalents.

Investments are selected for the portfolio after (1) going through a detailed financial analysis, and (2) being screened according to Oneida social criteria. Oneida Trust's social criteria targets companies that are making a positive contribution to society and the economy, specifically, those that support the interests of indigenous peoples and the preservation of land and water sources.

For portfolio management services, the Trust pays its investment adviser a calendar quarterly fee based on 0.30% of the Trust's net assets as of the last day of the previous quarter. For portfolio administration services, the Trust pays its administrator a calendar quarterly fee based on 0.09% of the Trust's net assets as of the last day of the previous quarter. All other operating expenses of the Trust are paid directly by the Oneida Trust Department. S&P500 Index is an index representing the average performance of 500 widely held publicly traded large capitalization stocks. Bloomberg Capital Intermediate Government/Credit index consists of all Barclay's Government and Corporate Bond indices, which contain bonds with maturities of one to ten years. The MSCI EAFE is an equity index with large and mid-cap representation across developed markets countries around the world excluding the U.S. and Canada. The indexes indicate how those securities performed in various time periods. Indexes are not managed and do not have fees.
