ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

BACKGROUND

On May 8, 2017, the Petitioners filed a complaint for probate of Daniel R. Parker's estate. The same complaint had already been filed by the Respondent in this case, in Brown County, case no. 16-PR-126 on November 15, 2016. Based on the dual filings, a jurisdictional allocation hearing, also known as a Teague hearing, was held on May 25, 2017. At the hearing, all parties present were heard and the Teague factors were considered. Based on the testimony and the Teague factors, it was decided the estate of Daniel R. Parker would continue in the Probate Branch of Brown County. On September 15, 2017, the Petitioners filed a transcript of the Teague hearing held on May 25, 2017.

ORDER

The Court orders as follows:

1. Any and all filings or correspondences regarding the probate of Daniel R. Parker's estate must be filed in Brown County with case no. 16-PR-126.
