ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Denice Beans presiding.

Background

At the monthly citation hearing on October 17, 2019 Attorney Garvey stated that Attorney Kelly McAndrews represents the citation cases and was called away for an emergency. Attorney Garvey recommended the Defendant contact Attorney McAndrews to discuss a possible settlement for this case. The Defendant agreed to contact Attorney McAndrews.

The Court granted the motion to hold the case open until the Defendant met with Attorney McAndrews. An order was issued on October 29, 2019 for the meeting to take place on or before November 8, 2019. In addition, Attorney McAndrews was to contact the Court about the status of the case on or before November 12, 2019.

Findings of Fact

The court finds as follows:

As of November 13, 2019, the Petitioner failed to prosecute and/or contact the Court about the status of the case on or before November 12, 2019.

Order

The court enters the following order:

Pursuant to 803.29-3 of the Oneida Judiciary Rules of Civil Procedure case #19-CT-010 is dismissed without prejudice.
