ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding.

Appearing in person: Attorney Carl Artman for the Petitioner: Oneida Nation/Oneida Police Department and Defendant Jordan M. Schuyler and Todd Schuyler.

Background

On October 15, 2019, Defendant was issued citations for Failure to Provide Food / Water 3 O.C. 304.6-1. 3 O.C. 304.6-1 requires a mandatory appearance in court. On December 19, 2019, a hearing was held, on the same date, the parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement with the court.

Findings of Fact

The court finds as follows:

1. The court has subject matter and personal jurisdiction over this matter.
2. On October 15, 2019, the Oneida Police Department cited the Defendant with Failure to Provide Food / Water 3 O.C. 304.6-1.
3. Defendant signed and submitted Acknowledgment of Rights form to the Court.
4. The parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement with the court on December 19, 2019, agreeing to amend Failure to Provide Food / Water citation 3 O.C. 304.6-1 to Animal Running At Large 3. O.C. 304.7-4. In doing so, Defendant admits to 3 O.C. 304.7-4 citation.
5. Petitioner requested maximum fine for first offense: Animal Running At Large be ordered in the amount of \$75.00, which was granted.
6. The Court adds court costs of \$25.00 for a total amount due of \$100.00 to be paid to the Oneida Judiciary within six months from the date this Order is signed.
7. The court agrees to the parties Stipulation and Agreement.

Order

1. The court amends the initial citation violation, 3 O.C. 304.6-1 to 3 O.C. 304.7-4.
2. The court orders Defendant to pay **\$100.00** to the Judiciary on or before six months from the date of this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
