FINAL ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

Appearing by phone: Attorney Kelly McAndrews representing the Petitioners. Defendant Lynn Webster-Acosta.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

A citation was issued to the Defendant on February 4, 2020 for violating Oneida Code of Laws section 304.6-5, Nuisance Animal, 3rd offense.

BACKGROUND

A hearing was scheduled for April 16, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. On April 3, 2020 the Petitioner filed a Motion for a Continuance. The Motion was granted. A hearing was held on May 21, 2020. The Petitioner motioned for a continuance. The motion was granted. A hearing was held on July 16, 2020.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. The Defendant received proper notice.
3. During the hearing, the parties agreed to a stipulation as follows:
 - a. Fine: \$75.00
 - b. Court costs: \$25.00
 - c. Six (6) months to pay in full.
 - d. Charge reduced from 3rd offense Nuisance Animal to 2nd offense Nuisance Animal.
4. The stipulation is reasonable.

ORDER

1. The above stipulation is approved.

2. The charge shall be reduced to 2nd offense for a Nuisance Animal.
3. Defendant shall pay to the Oneida Judiciary within six (6) months from the date this order is signed:

Fine:	\$75.00
Court Costs:	<u>\$25.00</u>
Total:	\$100.00
