This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

The Defendant was issued citations on October 4, 2019 for violating Oneida Code of Laws section 304.10-1 Dangerous Animals – 1<sup>st</sup> offense (19-TC-016), section 304.6-4 Animal Running at Large – 2<sup>nd</sup> offense (20-CT-013), and section 304.6-5 Nuisance Animal – 2<sup>nd</sup> offense (20-CT-014).

**BACKGROUND**

The Defendant did appear at the first hearing on February 20, 2020 at 9:00 am. The Petitioner conferred with the Defendant and the Defendant agreed to implement corrective measures to change the behavior of his dog so that it would not be getting loose. The Petitioner requested that the hearing be set out for a time, no later than May and that a Conditional Order be issued. The Court granted the request. A hearing was held on May 21, 2020. At the hearing, the Petitioner motioned for a continuance. The motion was granted. A hearing was held on July 16, 2020. At the hearing, the Petitioner motioned for a continuance. The motion was granted. A hearing was held on August 20, 2020 at which time the following agreement was reached and accepted by the Court:

Citations 19-CT-016 and 20-CT-014 will be dismissed without prejudice upon, the Defendant, showing proof to the Court that his dog, known as Hailee, receives a current rabies vaccination and is spaded within forty-five (45) days from the date of this hearing. The citation 20-CT-013 for Nuisance Animal will carry only the \$25.00 court costs to be remitted directly to the Oneida Judiciary within 30 days.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Court finds as follows:

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was given to all those entitled to notice.
3. On August 25, 2020, the Defendant paid the \$25.00 court costs for citation 20-CT-013.
4. On September 24, 2020, the Defendant filed proof the dog received a rabies vaccination and was spaded on September 23, 2020.
5. The Defendant met all the requirements of the agreement.

## **ORDER**

The Court enters the following order:

1. Citations 19-CT-016 and 20-CT-014 are dismissed without prejudice.
2. Citation 20-CT-013 is satisfied.
