ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding. *Appearing Telephonically:* Attorney Kelly McAndrews for the Petitioner: Oneida Nation/Oneida Police Department.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On April 19, 2020, the Defendant was issued citation 304.7-4, *Animal Running At Large*, 3rd offense. A citation hearing was held September 17, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. At the hearing, the Petitioner motioned to amend the violation code to reflect 304.6-4. The Defendant did not appear at the hearing.

FINDING OF FACTS

- 1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. On April 19, 2020, the Oneida Police Department issued a citation for violation of 8 O.C. 304.7-4.
- 3. A hearing was held on September 17, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.
- 4. The Defendant did not appear at the hearing.
 - a. In accordance with 8 O.C. 807.4-4, *Service by Publication*, the Petitioner met service requirement.
 - b. The Petitioner requested the Court to find the Defendant in default for failure to appear, which was granted.
- 5. At the hearing, the Petitioner requested to amend the violation code from 304.7-4 to 304.6-4, which was granted.
- 6. The Petitioner requested the maximum fine for 3rd offense: *Animal Running At Large* be ordered in the amount of \$500.00, which was granted.
- 7. The Court adds court costs of \$25.00 for a total amount due \$525.00 to be paid to the Oneida Judiciary within ninety (90) days from the date this order is signed.

ORDER

- 1. The Court amends the initial violation code, 3 O.C. 304.7-4 to 3 O.C. 304.6-4.
- 2. The Court orders Defendant to pay \$525.00 to the Judiciary on or before ninety (90) days from the date of this order.
