**BACKGROUND**

A citation was issued to the Defendant on June 1, 2020 for violating Oneida Code of Laws section 304.6-6, Failure to Comply with Ordered Quarantine. A hearing for this case was held on August 20, 2020 at 10:45am.

The Petitioner conferenced with the Defendant. Both parties agreed that the citation will be dismissed upon the Defendant showing proof to the Court that his dog received a rabies booster vaccination within 30 days from the date of this hearing.

The agreement is accepted by the Court.

**ORDER**

The Court enters the following order:

Pursuant to 803.21-1(b) of the Oneida Judiciary Rules of Civil Procedure case number 20-CT-017 is dismissed without prejudice upon the Defendant showing proof to the Court that his dog received a rabies booster vaccination within 30 days from the date of this hearing.

**The parties have the right to appeal within thirty (30) calendar days after the date this order or judgment is signed. A copy of the order will be mailed to all parties.**
