ENTRY OF SATISFACTION ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Patricia Ninham Hoeft presiding.

BACKGROUND

A citation was issued to Defendant on May 15, 2020, for violating the Oneida Nation’s Domestic Animals Law, section 304.6-4, for *Animal Running at Large*. A hearing was held on November 19, 2020 at 9:45 a.m. During the hearing, Petitioner conferenced with Defendant. The parties agreed to waive the citation fine, but Defendant is responsible to pay court costs of \$25.00. The Court accepted the agreement.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. On November 23, 2020, Respondent paid court costs of \$25.00.
3. The parties stipulated to waive the citation fine.
4. Citation 20-CT-027 is satisfied.
