

Brandon Yellowbird-Stevens (Turtle Clan) is serving his second term as Vice Chairman for the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin after previously serving as Councilman for 9 years.

Brandon attended the Oneida Tribal School throughout his grade school years before graduating from West De Pere High School in 1997. He earned his Associates Degree from the United Tribes Technical College in Bismarck, North Dakota and then to Haskell Indian Nations University where he earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and received his Masters of Business Administration from Lakeland University with a major in Finance.

Nationally he serves as the President of the National Haskell Board of Regents, Midwest Delegate for the National Indian Gaming Association Executive Board and serves on the Advisory Council of the My Brother's Keeper Alliance, a private sector initiative that brings together leaders from business, state and local governments, philanthropy, youth and nonprofit communities to address persistent opportunity gaps faced by underserved youth and men of color. Brandon was also a recipient of the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development's inaugural 40 under 40 Award that acknowledges leaders under 40 years of age for their contributions to their community and Indian Country.
