Kirby has represented the Oneida Nation in a variety of capacities focusing on tourism and sustaining Oneida. Prior to being elected as a Council Member, Kirby worked for the Oneida Tourism Department as a Special Events Tourism Coordinator for 26 years.

He served on the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council’s Tourism Advisory Committee for over 20 years. He is the Oneida representative to the Native American Tourism of Wisconsin (NATOW), a consortium of 11 tribes in Wisconsin that meet to share and promote tourism on their reservation. Kirby also served on the American Indian Alaska Native Tourism Association Board of Directors and represented the Midwest region for 14 years. He also serves on the Woodland Indians Arts Board and has been a member of the Oneida Hymn Singers for 50 years.
