STATUS SUMMARY

The next TCC meeting is scheduled for Friday, September 17 at 1:30 pm. The following subcommittees will give their reports to the TCC:

TAP staff will notify the TCC and the subcommittee members that the upcoming subcommittee meetings we want to start working on putting together Long-term goals as there currently is none for the TAP.

TAP staff will continue to meet with subcommittees to start working on the objectives for each goal for the TAP.

TAP has been working on the issue about Sharps being found throughout the community. Currently, we are working with OBH to see if we could contract with Vivent Health on a needle exchange program. **Update** MOU has been signed, Vivent Health will be meeting with OBH staff to set up training and program logistics. – **No update**

TAP is collaborating with the Native Justice Coalition to do a virtual presentation for the community on Harm Reduction. The Partnership agreement has been sent up to the Law Office for review. We are planning to have this presentation in November. Leslie will be working on the flyer for this event. Our next planning meeting is on September 28, 2021.

TAP has been collaborating with OBH on planning for a Community Virtual Scavenger Hunt. This will start in May for community members. **Update:** OBH is working with Forrest Pelky on the scan codes. The first month questions and participation incentives are ready. – **No update**

TAP is planning to have an informational presentation on Medically Assisted Treatment (MAT) done for adults in the community. Will be working with OBH to plan this event. **Update:** TAP will be collaborating with OBH, to do a Medically Assisted Training (MAT) information presentation for community members. **OBH is currently short staffed and will be working with Mari to set up a time to go over planning for this.**

Smudge walks – Due to the “No Public Gathering” we are temporarily putting smudge walks on hold.

TAP will be having an informational table at the “Back to School Bash” Event that is being sponsored by Oneida Comprehensive Housing which will be held on August 3, 2021. **Update:** This event has been switched to a virtual event which will be held on August 24 @ 4:00 pm in Three Sisters. TAP assisted with this event and put together informational folders on drugs and alcohol use for teens to be put in the backpacks – We handed out 100 of those folders.

TAP is collaborating with Big Bear Media for showing of a Documentary “Scattering CJ” on Friday, August 27 (Day before the Pow wow) The documentary is about suicide. **Update:** We are working with Big Bear Media and Sparks Media to plan on doing a virtual showing for the community. Our next meeting is in the process of being set up.

TAP staff is assisting OBH with the planning of the Kunhi-yo Healing event on August30, Sept. 1 & 2. **Update:** TAP staff assisted OBH with their Virtual Registration, Drive Through and Virtual presentation.

TAP staff will be having Twa ta;t (Let’s Talk) events on Fridays **Update:** Due to the “No Public Gathering” we put these on hold..

Community Clean up – Due to the “No Public Gathering” we are temporarily putting these on hold.

Move – TAP staff will be moving to the Social Services Building – 3rd floor. Our anticipated move date will be on Wednesday, September 22. We will be housed in rooms E322, E323 and E324.

TAP newsletter – TAP staff has put together a quarterly newsletter to be mailed out. This is currently at Big Bear and they are working with the enrollment department to get this mailed out. Hopefully it gets out this week.

Administrative Assistant – the posting to hire an administrative assistant has been posted with HRD. Looking to hire asap.
