



Oneida Nation Public Health Officer Extends Face Covering Requirement Through January 22, 2022

For immediate release: November 23, 2021

(Oneida Reservation) –The Oneida Nation Public Health Officer has extended the Public Health Order requiring facial coverings on the Oneida Nation Reservation. The extension is based on current Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance and increasing COVID-19 infection rates.

In summary, the mandate continues to require:

Regardless of vaccination status, to wear a face covering in settings where two or more people not living in the same house occupy the same indoor or enclosed space located on the Oneida Reservation or otherwise subject to the jurisdiction or authority of the Oneida Nation.

This requirement is to protect all Oneida employees, our customers and the general public.
