Effective Jan 3 2022

COVID test is positive, or person has COVID symptoms and refuses to test

-Isolate for 5 days, whether person has symptoms or not. The 5 day clock starts the day that symptoms developed, or the test date if there were no symptoms

-If symptoms are resolving, this person can return to school on day 6. Person must continue to wear a mask in all settings

-If symptoms have not improved after 5 days of isolation, must continue to isolate until feeling better
