






Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

RESOLUTION # <u>8-06-03-A</u>

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian

government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of

Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the

Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council. and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has determined as part of its Seventh Generation Commitment, "To develop a

provisional system that fits our "family"/community values such as food, shelter, clothing and

employment as well as other services," and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has established the Oneida Social Services/Center for Self-Sufficiency to

promote quality educational, employment and support services for needy Indian families, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe with the collaboration of the United States Department of Health and Human

Services/Compassion Capital fund Targeted Capacity-Building Program would like to provide quality, culturally appropriate shelter services to homeless Indian youth and families on or near the

Oneida Reservation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin/Center for Self-Sufficiency in collaboration with the United States Department of Health and Human Services/Office of Community Services/A.C.F./Compassion Capital Fund, Targeted Capacity-Building Program authorizes and submits this grant application to support homeless youth and families on or near the Oneida Reservation.
