## TIPS FOR SHOPPING AT THE FARMER MARKET THIS SUMMER!!

**Shop early (or late)** — Go to the market early to get the best selection and to avoid the crowds. Or go to the market later, when the produce is often sold at a discounted price.

**Do a lap** — Walk through the market first before purchasing anything. You might spot some great looking veggies early on, but later down the market, find better looking or cheaper veggies!

**Bring canvas or other reusable bags** — They are stronger and you can fit more of your fresh fruits and veggies safely in a sturdy bag.

**Try something new** — spend time talking with farmers about their produce! They often have great tips on how to best eat or prepare their fruits and veggies!

**Shop Local** — Buy only Wisconsin grown fruits and veggies with your Farmers' Market checks. If you see something that's not usually grown in Wisconsin, ask the farmer where it's grown!
