1 PURPOSE

To maximize the personal safety of students, employees, and visitors, to the Norbert Hill Center and to protect the Nation's assets, including equipment and information housed at this location.

2 **DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 <u>Access Card:</u> A plastic wallet-sized card that provides access to specified areas of the NHC Building by electronic means.
- 2.2 <u>Access Control:</u> Control of an entry/exit to an area. A service feature or technique used to permit or deny entry for individuals or groups to the NHC Building.
- 2.3 <u>Building Liaison:</u> The employee appointed by the Oneida Business Committee to be responsible for the adherence and implementation of this policy. This role may have a variety of job titles.
- 2.4 <u>Direct Reports:</u> Direct Reports to the Oneida Business Committee as defined by resolution.
- 2.5 <u>Escort:</u> NHC Building employee who will walk with the Visitor to their designated location and return them to the reception area at the end of their visit.
- 2.6 Exterior Doors: A door that opens to the outside of the NHC Building.
- 2.7 Interior Doors: A door that is between a variety of internal areas including offices,
