for the FY23 ONEIDA FINANCE FUND

The Finance Committee is now taking **Oneida Finance Fund** applications (formerly the Community Fund) for the FY 2023 Fiscal Year. The purpose of this fund remains the same: to serve the Oneida community by offering funds and/or Coca-Cola products for Oneida families and local events. The Oneida Finance Fund is available to all Wisconsin enrolled Oneida members and is designated specifically for:

- 1. Self-Enrichment (for youth and adults),
- 2. Oneida Community Events and
- 3. Fundraisers that benefit Oneida members or the Community

The Finance Committee is cognizant of the ongoing pandemic and encourages all requesters to choose virtual and or safe activities for their families. All funding requests do obligate the requester to provide a 10% match. Individual can request up to \$500.00 once per year/per person and Groups may requests up to \$750.00 once per year/per group.

The Finance Committee reviews requests at their first meeting of the month. There is one application for funding requests and one application for product requests. The FY23 packets/forms are available on the Oneida Tribal Website page under the Finance Committee. You can also contact the Finance Administration Office via their e-mail address: FAO@oneidanation.org to obtain/submit applications or to find out more information.

All requesters are asked to submit requests at least six weeks before actual need or event date. Completed forms and back up information are to be *E-Mailed* to the above address in PDF format only. For those without computer access you can mail your completed application with backup information to Oneida Finance Administration Office, Attn: Oneida Finance Fund, P.O. Box 365, Oneida, WI 54155.

NOTE: The Oneida Finance Fund does not review any travel or travel related requests; requests that can be obtained from another tribal program; or any type of personal request. Tribal programs are also excluded from funding requests, but may be eligible for product requests, provided the event is open, safe and benefits the community/public. No request will be reviewed if requester has received funding in FY2022 and has not submitted the required follow-up report.
