## MINUTES:

Attorney Meghan MacKelly appeared by phone on behalf of creditor, Mariner Finance, LLC. Debtor Jessica Powless did not appear. Creditor requested \$150.25 be garnished from Debtor's weekly earnings, which is 20% of disposable earnings, the maximum withholding amount allowable per pay period. Because Debtor failed to appear, the Court finds Debtor in default and grants creditor's motion for a weekly garnishment of \$150.25 plus a \$1.00 Oneida Nation Accounting Department weekly processing fee until Debtor's total debt owed is paid in full.

## **THE COURT FINDS:**

1. That Debtor is an employee of the Oneida Nation,
2. That the Debtor is subject to the jurisdiction of the Oneida Judiciary,
3. That Debtor's wages are under the control of the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Department,
4. That a valid judgment had been docketed against Debtor in a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction in the amount of \$3,868.23,
5. That it is the responsibility of the Debtor and Creditor to keep a record of total payments applied to this debt. The Accounting Department shall: (a) Send to the creditor the allowable amount garnished from the employee's paycheck following each payroll period. (b) Notify the employee and creditor when the garnishments are terminated.

**[ X ] THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS:** the above creditor is awarded a court default judgment. Effective September 14, 2022, the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Office is hereby directed to deduct from the weekly wages of the Debtor named above in the sum of 20% per week. The Creditor shall file a Notice of Satisfaction with the Court when the judgment has been satisfied through wage garnishment.
