## MINUTES:

Attorney Richard Stueckroth appeared by phone for creditor, BCG Equities LLC. Debtor Hartman Skenandore appeared in person. Parties agreed \$35.00 is to be garnished from Debtor's weekly earnings. The Court finds the agreement acceptable and orders a weekly garnishment of \$35.00 plus a \$1.00 Oneida Nation Accounting Department weekly processing free until Debtor's total debt is paid in full.

## THE COURT FINDS:

- 1. That Debtor is an employee of the Oneida Nation,
- 2. That the Debtor is subject to the jurisdiction of the Oneida Judiciary,
- 3. That Debtor's wages are under the control of the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Department,
- 4. That a valid judgment had been docketed against Debtor in a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction in the amount of \$5,424.53,
- 5. That it is the responsibility of the Debtor and Creditor to keep a record of total payments applied to this debt. The Accounting Department shall: (a) Send to the creditor the allowable amount garnished from the employee's paycheck following each payroll period. (b) Notify the employee and creditor when the garnishments are terminated.

[X] THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS: the above creditor is awarded a Court judgment. Effective January 25, 2023, the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Office is hereby directed to deduct from the weekly wages of the Debtor named above in the sum of \$35.00 per week. The Creditor shall file a Notice of Satisfaction with the Court when the judgment has been satisfied through wage garnishment.

Unpaid balance of judgment: \$5,424.53

Post Judgment Interest: \$1,945.40

Filing fee costs: \$25.00

Total amount owed by the debtor: \$7,394.93

The amount to be remitted directly to Dobberstein Law Firm until such time as said debt is paid in full.
