Oneida Nation Arts Program - Dollars for Art Program Grants Available

Preregistration Deadline: Friday, July 7, 2023 Application Deadline: Friday, July 28, 2023

The Dollars for Arts Program (DAP) is part of a regranting program funded by the Wisconsin Arts Board and the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin. DAP provides funds for artistic and projects in both traditional and contemporary styles of dance, literature, music, theatre and visual arts. The application process is competitive, and applicants are not guaranteed funding.

The Oneida Nation Arts Board (ONAB) reviews the applications and awards the DAP grants every year. The applicants are rated by a Peer Panel Review and funds are allocated by the ONAB based on the recommendations of the panel review.

There are three funding areas in DAP:

Artist Development Awards – are available to artists in the community who have identified a special project that will enhance their professional development and benefit the Oneida community. If awarded, grant funds can finance up to 50% of the artists' project expenses as DAP requires a dollar for dollar match.

Community/Group Awards – are available to community groups or tribal programs for art projects that are new and innovative or significantly enhance an existing program in the Oneida community. The dollar for dollar match pertains to Community/Group Awards as well.

Fellowship Award – is a \$1000 cash award to an Oneida artist for artistic excellence. There is a maximum of one Fellowship available per fiscal year. Fellowship applicants must identify a special project that will benefit the community. There is no cash match requirement, however, the \$1000 award must be used toward the identified project.

Those interested in applying for a DAP grant must preregister on Community Pass by Friday, July 7, 2023 – https://register.communitypass.net/OneidaNation. The deadline for submitting grant applications is Friday, July 28, 2023. Projects and activities must occur between October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024.
