## Oneida Family Fitness Membership Policy

By signing your Membership Contract, Member(s) acknowledge and agree that all facility and/ or membership policies will be adhered to and followed.

- 1. Members are required to interact with others in a caring, honest, respectful, and responsible manner to encourage **Kahletsyalu!sla**: the heartfelt encouragement of the best in each of us.
- 2. Memberships (Individual and Family Plans) are available for Oneida Enrolled Tribal members, Oneida Descendants, Oneida Nation Employees, and Other Tribe Affiliations:
  - a. Must show/provide \*Proof of ID to be eligible for Membership Plans.
    - \*Acceptable forms of ID, include:
      - Oneida Enrollment ID
      - Descendancy Documentation
      - Oneida Employee Badge
      - Other Tribe Enrollment ID
  - b. "Family Membership" means all members must reside in the same household.
- 3. Memberships are available to Ages 13 and older.
- 4. Members must present their membership card upon entering. OFF reserves the right to refuse entry for any individual who does not present a membership card or other identification.
- 5. Memberships are non-transferable. Members may not sell or loan their membership card or privileges.
- 6. No Guests will be allowed.
- 7. NO SMOKING is allowed within 30 feet of the building. NO USE OF VAPES allowed inside facility.
- 8. Clean, personal hygiene and appropriate fitness attire is required (Shorts, closed-toe shoes, t-shirts, sweats, socks).
- 9. Anyone who carelessly and/or negligently breaks or damages OFF equipment will be charged accordingly.
- 10. Music is played throughout the facility. Members may choose to use their own personal headphones for music. Personal speakers, including the use of a phone speaker, are not allowed.
- 11. No skateboarding is allowed on OFF property or in parking lot areas.
- 12. Registered sex offenders are not entitled to membership at OFF. The applicant is responsible for informing OFF of any such status and any change in such status.
- 13. OFF's Disciplinary Policy Applies to members.
  - a. Loitering is not allowed on Oneida Family Fitness property.
  - The use of profanity or disrespecting OFF Staff, Administration Staff and/or other members will
    not be tolerated.

- c. No fighting, possession of weapons, theft, destruction of property or personal belongings, and use of alcohol and/or drugs are strictly prohibited.
- d. See the OFF Disciplinary Policy for further information concerning prohibited behaviors. OFF has discretion concerning memberships and may refuse, condition, suspend, or revoke a membership in accordance with its Disciplinary Policy. Membership determinations are not appealable.

Refusal to follow facility policies may result in conditioning, suspension, and/ or revocation of membership privileges; Illegal or suspected illegal behavior may be reported to law enforcement.
