**ORDER**

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, the Honorable John E. Powless, III presiding.

*Appearing In-person:* Plaintiffs' Attorney, Kelly McAndrews; and Defendant, Adrian John Lecker.

**Background**

In accordance with 3 O.C. 309.9-4, Defendant was issued Furnishing Alcoholic Beverages to Minors, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense citation, as a result of an incident that occurred on April 22, 2023, on the Oneida Reservation. On October 19, 2023, a citation pre-trial hearing was held, at which time the parties proposed a stipulated agreement for the Court to consider.

**Analysis**

At the citation pre-trial hearing, the parties reached an agreement in which Defendant plead No Contest to an amended violation, 3 O.C. 309.9-3, Underage Possession of Alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense. In doing so, Defendant agreed to pay amended Underage Possession of Alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense fine of \$100.00 and \$25.00 in court costs to the Oneida Judiciary within thirty (30) days of a signed court order.

**Finding of Facts**

1. The Court has subject matter and personal jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Defendant was issued Furnishing Alcoholic Beverages to Minors, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense citation and received proper notice of this hearing.
3. Defendant acknowledged his rights at the citation pre-trial hearing.
4. At the citation pre-trial hearing, the parties proposed the following stipulation and agreement to the Court for consideration:
  - a. Defendant plead No Contest to an amended violation, 309.9-3, Underage Possession of Alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense.
    - i. As a result, Defendant agreed to pay \$100.00 citation fine and \$25.00 in court

costs within thirty (30) days of a signed court order.

5. The Court accepted and approved the parties stipulated agreement.
6. Defendant plead NO CONTEST to Underage Possession of Alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense and therefore, the Court finds Defendant GUILTY.
7. On October 19, 2023, Defendant filed proof of payment for \$100.00 fine and \$25.00 in court costs to the Oneida Judiciary regarding 23-CT-084.
8. Defendant satisfied all conditions in the Court approved stipulation.

**Order**

1. The Court accepted and approved the parties stipulated agreement.
2. As a result, Defendant shall pay the following fine and court costs to the Oneida Judiciary on or before December 13, 2023:

**23-CT-084, Underage Possession of Alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense, 3 O.C. 309.9-3.**

Fine: \$100.00


Court costs: \$25.00

**Total amount owed by Defendant \$125.00 (Paid October 19, 2023)**

3. Defendant satisfied all conditions in the Court approved stipulation.
4. This case is closed.
