The Green Bay Conservation Corps is accepting applications for crew member positions starting as early as March 4<sup>th</sup>! We have a variety of commitment levels available. All positions receive a monthly living allowance, flexible scheduling, extensive training and career development opportunities, and after completing the term, result in an education award. See more details in the table below to find the best option for you!

So, what does a crew member do? Last year, the Conservation Corps crews were busy restoring and improving City parks, trails, and greenways. Some of our 2023 accomplishments include:

- Removing nearly 100 acres of invasive species (including buckthorn, honeysuckle, and garlic mustard).
- Improving over 2 miles of trails and corridors.
- Collect native plant seeds and growing nearly 3,000 plants in our greenhouse.
- Mapping and surveying all 67 parks for pollinator habitat and creating a city-wide map.
- Engaging over 200+ volunteers to assist with these projects.
- Maintaining all biofilters, rain gardens, and native plantings throughout the parks system.
- Converting nearly 3,000sqft of turf grass into native habitat and a rain garden.
- Planting 20,000 donated native plugs across the parks system.
