

Directions:

- * Cut out the Core Value Catcher along the outside line.
- * With the printed side up, fold the square in half horizontally & then vertically. Open the folds. (This helps you later...)
- *Turn the square over.
- *Fold each corner over so they meet in the middle. Do NOT let them overlap-do it carefully.
- *Leave the square folded, & flip it over.
- * Now fold the corners into the center-make sure they do not overlap.
- *Fold the entire **S**quare in half & gently poke your thumbs & forefingers in under the flaps.
- *Bring your fingers together so the Core Value Catcher forms a peak. *SatewY^n^ta.u! (You are ready!)
