All positions receive a monthly living allowance, flexible scheduling, extensive training and career development opportunities, and after completing the term, result in an education award. So, what does a crew member do? Last year, the Conservation Corps crews were busy restoring and improving City parks, trails, and greenways. Some of our 2023 accomplishments include:

- Removing nearly 100 acres of invasive species (including buckthorn, honeysuckle, and garlic mustard). Improving over 2 miles of trails and corridors.
- Collect native plant seeds and growing nearly 3,000 plants in our greenhouse.
- Mapping and surveying all 67 parks for pollinator habitat and creating a city-wide map.
- Engaging over 200+ volunteers to assist with these projects.
- Maintaining all biofilters, rain gardens, and native plantings throughout the parks system.
- Converting nearly 3,000sqft of turf grass into native habitat and a rain garden.
- Planting 20,000 donated native plugs across the parks system.
