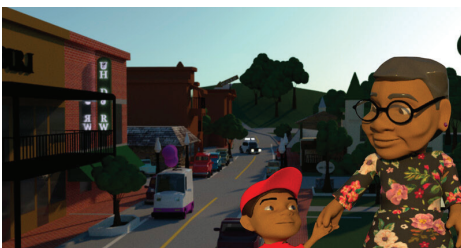


Rabbit Stories *

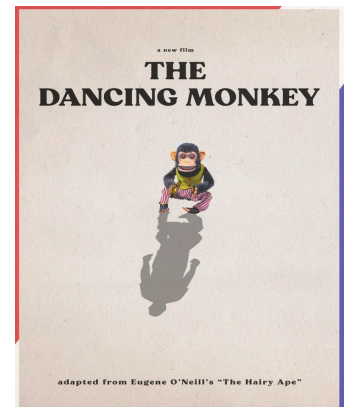


The Dancing Monkey
