I'm sending this parent letter to let you know that Grade 4 and 5 students will be participating in human growth and development classes **Lanunhatényehse?** (*Their lives are changing-puberty.*)

Lanunhatényehse? consists of **Wa?yakunhate·ní**· (*Her life changed, Girl to Woman*) and **Wahlunhate·ní**· (*His life changed, Boy to Man*.) This class speaks of the traditional roles, responsibilities, and values of what it means to become an Oneida woman or man. We also teach the physical changes that occur during puberty. We will discuss the structure and function of the human reproductive system, and will explain the physical, emotional and social changes that occur during puberty. Girls and boys meet in separate groups to discuss their unique physical changes. We also want students to have open communication with parents about this topic.
