**SUBJECT: 2024 SPECIAL ELECTION CAUCUS**

The 2024 Special Election Caucus is set for Saturday, April 6, 2024, at 11:00 a.m. in the Business Committee Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, at the Norbert Hill Center.

Nominations will be conducted for the vacancies listed. Any person nominated at the Caucus **must** be present to accept/decline the nomination. All other individuals may petition to have their name placed on the 2024 General Election Ballot.

- Individuals nominated will need to complete a separate application for **each** position they were nominated for.
- Individuals petitioning to have their name placed on the ballot will need to complete a separate application and petition for each position they are vying for.

Applications and petitions will be available at the Caucus or may be picked up at the Government Administrative Office. The deadline to submit applications, petitions and/or other supporting documents to the Government Administrative Office is:

**FRIDAY – APRIL 12, 2024, BY 4:30 P.M.**
