

CDC# 21-112 - Transitional Residential Detox Treatment Facility

Project Description:

The purpose of this project is to conduct a feasibility study to understand the potential for the Oneida Nation to operate their own detox and/ or transitional living facility. Services include conducting a market analysis, financial analysis, and feasibility study for addiction recovery services including detoxification treatment, transitional/residential housing, and associated behavioral health providers for the community Oneida’s Comprehensive Health Division serves.

The Engineering Department has contracted with two Consultants to complete the feasibility study.

- Wipfli, LLP. - Wipfli will create a feasibility study to assess the level of support and anticipated financial results of Oneida offering these services, and ultimately if the project makes sense for Oneida to undertake.
- DSGW Architects - DSGW will provide facility programming services that correlate with the feasibility study services Wipfli, LLP is performing

Current Status:

Wipfli recently conducted multiple stakeholder interview sessions to assess current challenges and opportunities relating to detox treatment and services, transitional living resources, staffing, etc.
