- 1. Campsite check-in is 3:00p.m. and check-out is 11:00a.m.
- 2. NO recreation trailer, pickup truck camper, or motor home may occupy a campsite.
- 3. A maximum of three (3) tents are allowed on sites and must be located within the defined boundaries.
- 4. Leave no trace policy "Pack It In...Pack It Out" You are responsible for removing your trash/recycling with you when you vacate the camp area.
- 5. NO illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages or glass bottles allowed on grounds.
- 6. NO recreation trailer, pickup truck camper, or motor home may occupy a campsite.
- 7. NO ATV/UTV vehicles.
- 8. NO fireworks or explosive materials.
- 9. **Quiet Time Between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.** The camp sites are closed to non-campers/visitors between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
- 10. Pets must be leashed and kept on a leash not exceeding 6 feet. Pets are NOT allowed in buildings, beaches, playgrounds, and picnic areas.
- 11. Fires are allowed in fire rings and grills only.
- 12. Do not leave fires unattended and put out all fires before leaving.
- 13. Oneida Nation and EHSL&A Division are **NOT** responsible for loss or damage of property due to negligence, accident, vandalism, theft, or acts of nature.
