Build Your Own Rain Barrel

Supplies Provided (along with instruction manual):

1. 55-gallon food-grade barrel (**DO NOT** use for food)
2. Diverter
3. Fill Hose
4. Winterizing Hole Cover
5. Spigot Drain with Cap
6. Rubber Seals



Tools (to have at home to construct):

- ✚ **Note:** Barrels will be pre-drilled for the spigot
- Drill/DIY Rain B
- Tape Measure
- Silicone Sealant or Plumbing Goop (for sealing the spigot)
- Teflon tape
- Environmentally friendly paint: If you choose to paint your barrel (see below)



How to paint your barrel:

1. Wipe down the barrel with a one-to-one mixture of vinegar and water
2. Rough the surface of the barrel with a piece of fine grit sandpaper
3. Apply a coat of latex bonding primer
4. Paint your design with "exterior latex paint"
