Yakona?khwá·u - She's angry  
Lona?khwá·u - He's angry

Tesa?nikú·lyahks kΛ - Are you sad?  
Tewake?nikú·lyahks - I'm sad.  
Teyako?nikú·lyahks - She's sad.  
Teho?nikú·lyahks - He's sad.

Setsá·nihse? kΛ - Are you afraid?  
Ketsá·nihse? - I'm afraid  
Latsá·nihse? - He's afraid.  
Yetsá·nihse? - She's afraid.

Satse·yálu? kΛ - Are you shy?  
Wakatse·yálu? - I am shy  
Yakotse·yálu? - She's shy.  
Lotse·yálu? - He's shy.

Negatives:

Yah tesatunháhele? - Your not happy.  
Yah te?wakatunháhele? - I'm not happy.  
Yah te?yakotunháhele? - She's not happy.  
Yah tehotunháhele? - He's not happy.

Yah tesana?khwá·u - You are not angry  
Yah te?wakna?khwá·u - I'm not angry  
Yah te?yakona?khwá·u - She's not angry  
Yah tehona?khwá·u - He's not angry

Yah tha?tesa?nikú·lyahks - Your not sad  
Yah tha?tewake?nikú·lyahks - I'm not sad.  
Yah tha?teyako?nikú·lyahks - She's not sad.  
Yah tha?teho?nikú·lyahks - He's not sad.

Yah tehsetsá·nihse? - Your afraid  
Yah te?ketsá·nihse? - I'm not afraid  
Yah te?yetsá·nihse? - She's not afraid.  
Yah tehatsá·nihse? - He's not afraid.

Yah tesatse·yálu? - Your not shy  
Yah te?wakatse·yálu? - I'm not shy  
Yah te?yakotse·yálu? - She's not shy.  
Yah tehotse·yálu? - He's not shy.

Conversation:

Satunháhele? kΛ - Are you happy?

Wakatunháhele? - I am happy.

OR

Yah te?wakatunháhele? - I am not happy.

Ot niyohtuháti - How is it going?

Wakatunháhele? - I am happy

Ot niyohtuháti ya?níha - How is it going (for) your father?

Lotunháhele? - He is happy.

OR

Yah tehotunháhele? - He is not happy.

Ot niyohtuháti sanulhá - How is it going (for) your mother?

Teyako?nikú·lyahks - She is sad.

Lotunháhele? kΛ ya?níha - Is he happy, your father?

Á·Λ, lotunháhele? - Yes, he's happy

OR

Yah tehotunháhele? - He is not happy.
