Teyohwish $\lambda$ he·yú	- It/Elder Female is tired

Yah tha <sup>?</sup> tesahwish $\lambda$ he·yú	- Your not tired
Yáh tha <sup>?</sup> tewakhwis $\lambda$ he·yú	- I'm not tired
Yah tha <sup>?</sup> teyakohwish $\lambda$ he·yú	- Sh's not tired
Yah tha <sup>?</sup> tehohwish $\lambda$ he·yú	- He's not tired
Yah tha <sup>?</sup> teyohwish $\lambda$ he·yú	- It/Elder Female is not tired

## Healthy(lively, active)

Sata <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	Your healthy
Wakata <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- I'm healthy
Yakota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- She'm healthy
Lota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- He's healthy
Yota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- It/Elder Female is healthy

Yah te <sup>?</sup> sata <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- Your not healthy
Yah te <sup>?</sup> wakata <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- I'm not well (healthy)
Yah te <sup>?</sup> yakota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- She's not healthy
Yah tehota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- He's not healthy
Yah te <sup>?</sup> yota <sup>?</sup> kali·té:	- It/Elder Female is not healthy

## Glad, happy (-atshanuni-)

Satshanuní ká	-Are you glad?
Satshanu·ní	-You are glad
Wakatshanuní	-I'm glad
Yakotshanuní	-She's glad
Lotshanuní	-He's glad

Yáhte <sup>?</sup> satshanu·ní	-Your not are glad
Yáhte <sup>?</sup> wakatshanu·ní	-I'm not glad
Yáhte <sup>?</sup> yako tshanu·ní	-She's not glad
Yáhte <sup>?</sup> hotshanu·ní	-He's not glad

## Cold, become

Swístohse <sup>?</sup>	- Your cold
Kwístohse <sup>?</sup>	- I'm cold
Yewístohse <sup>?</sup>	- She's cold
Lawístohse <sup>?</sup>	- He's cold
Kawístohse <sup>?</sup>	- It/Elder Female is cold

Yah te <sup>?</sup> swístohse <sup>?</sup>	- Your not cold
Yah te <sup>?</sup> kwístohse <sup>?</sup>	- I'm not cold.
Yah te <sup>?</sup> yewístohse <sup>?</sup>	- She's not cold
Yah tehawístohse <sup>?</sup>	- He's not cold
Yah te <sup>?</sup> kawístohse <sup>?</sup>	- It/Elder Female is not cold

Simple question and possible answers:

Sanuhwáktanihe? kλ - Are you sick?

Á·Λ, waknuhwáktanihe? - I'm sick

Yah te?waknuhwáktanihe? - I'm not sick

Questions and answers with family members:

Yewístohse? kλ sanulhá - Is she cold, your mother? (Is your mother cold?)

Á·Λ, yewístohse? - Yes, she's cold

OR

Á·Λ, yewístohse? né· aknulhá - Yes, she's cold, my mother.

Sample conversations using Ot niyohtuháti:

Ot niyohtuháti - How is it going?

Tewakhwishλhe·yú - I'm tired.

Ot niyohtuháti sanulhá - How is it going (for) your mother?

Yakonuhwáktanihe? - She's sick

OR

Yakonuhwáktanihe? né· aknulhá - She's sick, my mother.

Ot niyohtuháti ya?níha - How is it going (for) your father?

Tehohwishλhe·yú - He's tired

OR

Tehohwishλhe·yú né· lake?níha - He's tired, my father.
