Background

- First conducted in 2000 by Governmental Services
 Division, then again in 2008. In 2010, the Statistics
 Office began administering the survey every 2 years.
- Gathers information from enrolled Oneidas regarding their views on various social, cultural, health, economic, educational, governmental and other Tribal related issues
- Gauges overall quality of life of Oneida members who live in Brown & Outagamie Counties
- Collects members' perceptions of Oneida programs and services
- Identifies current demographic statistics




Methodology

- Survey sent to all Oneida households in Brown and Outagamie Counties
 - Respondents could respond through mail or online
 - Sent end of August 2022
- 384 Total Responses (14% response rate)
 - 250 living on the Oneida Reservation
 - 120 off the Reservation in Brown & Outagamie






