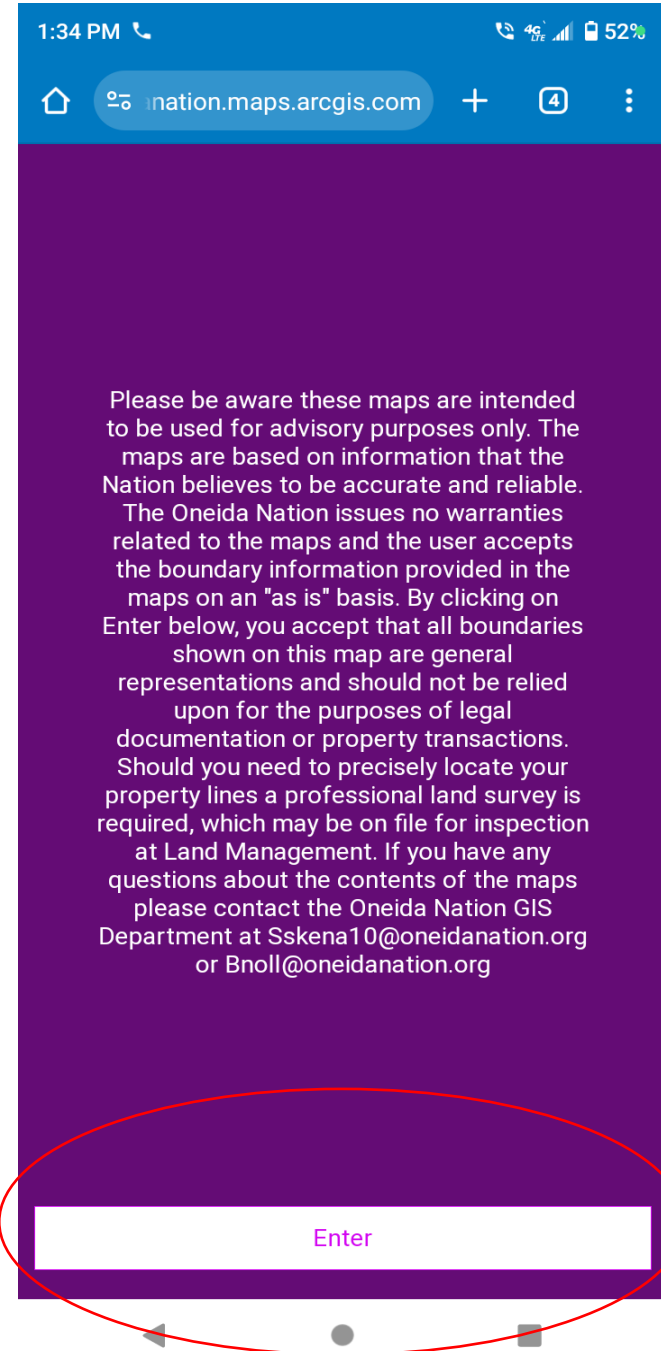


- Upon entering the link, you will be greeted by this Legal Notice

 - Once you are done reading, press enter



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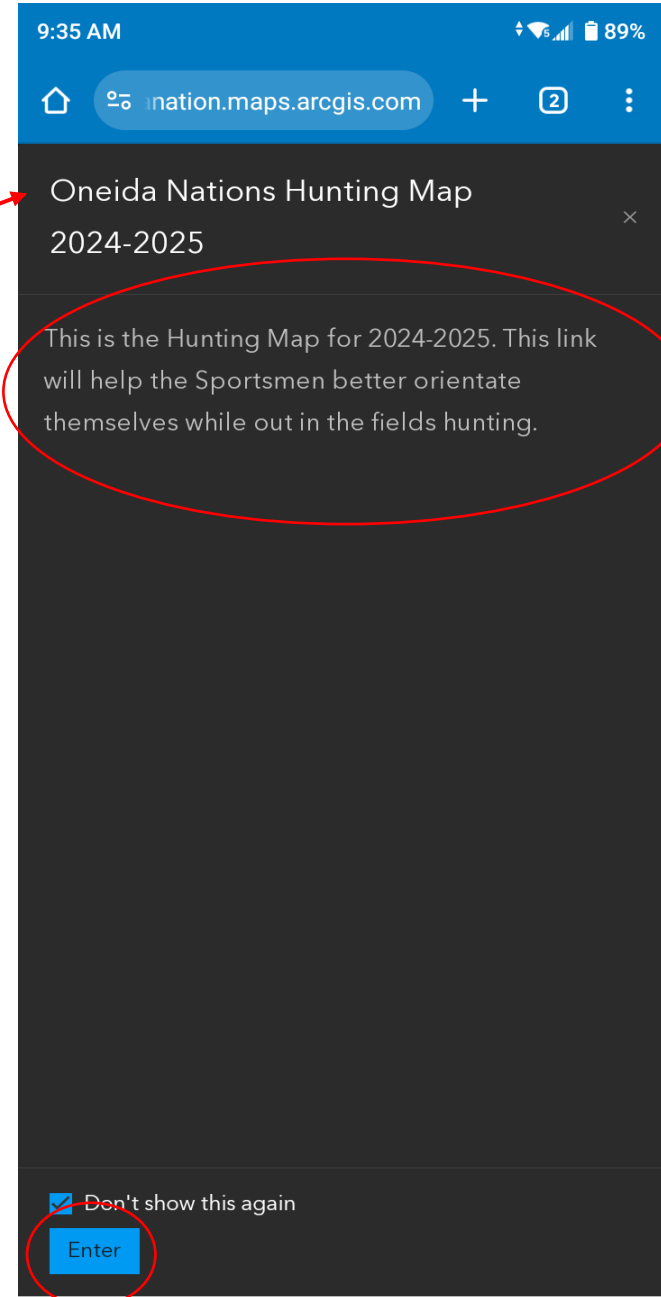
Getting Started

- This is the title of the map
- This notice is a description of the map you are about to view
- Press enter to continue to the map



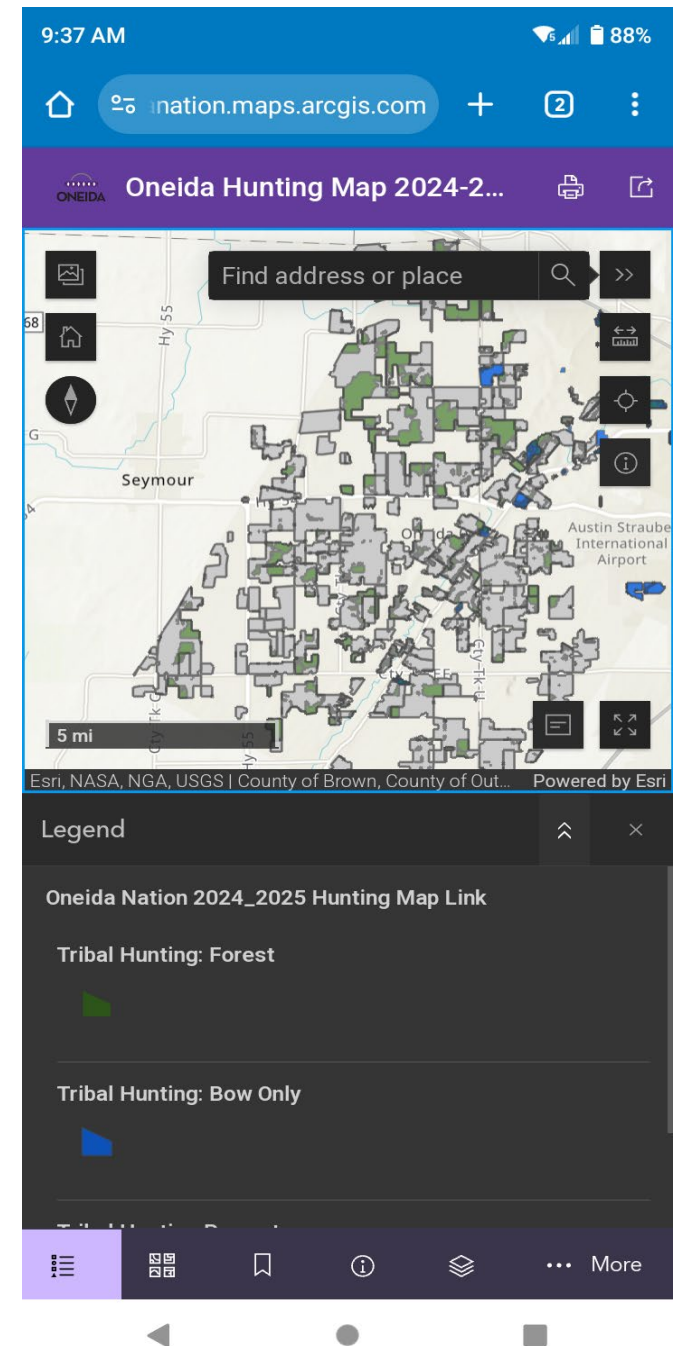
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Getting Started-The Base Map



- The base map will be the first thing shown upon opening the website
- If your map is completely dark, you may need to turn off some layers (Next Slide)

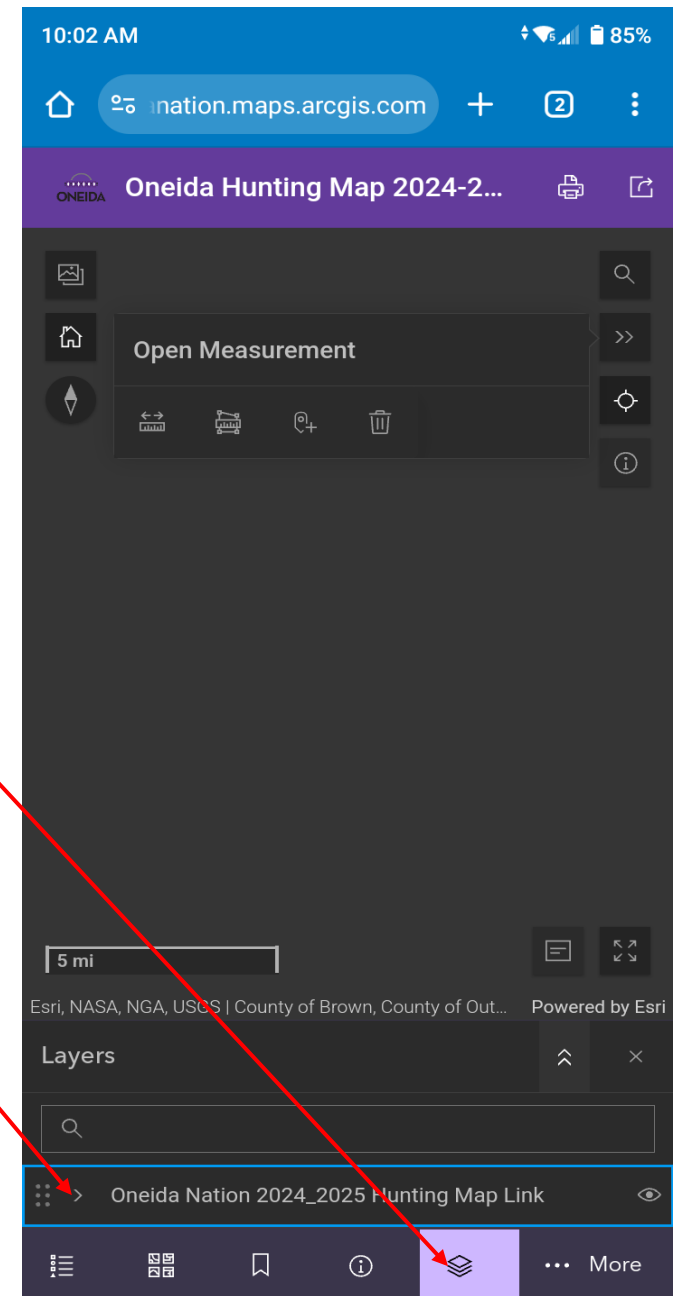


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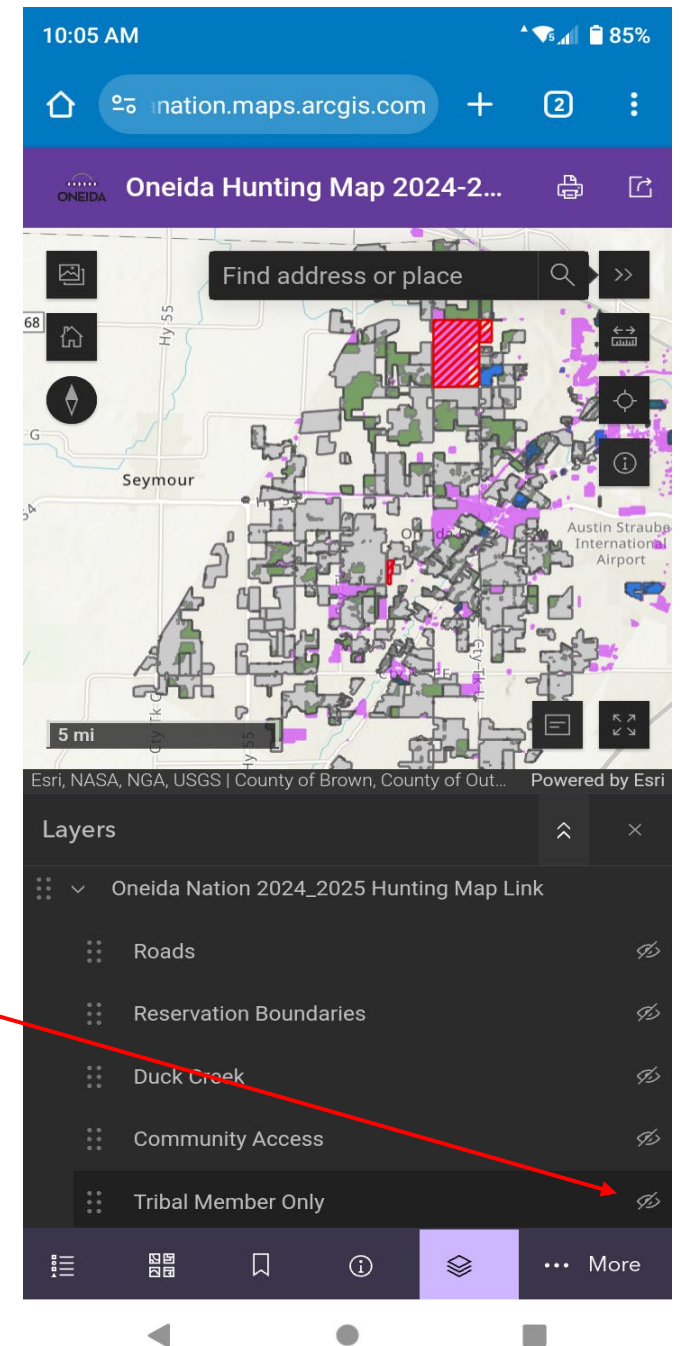
Getting Started-The Base Map

- To turn off layers:
 - Click the Layers Tab on the bottom 
 - Then Click the drop to arrow to view all layers 



Getting Started-The Base Map

- To turn off layers:
 - Click on individual layers to turn them on and off
 - This symbol,  means the layer has been turned OFF

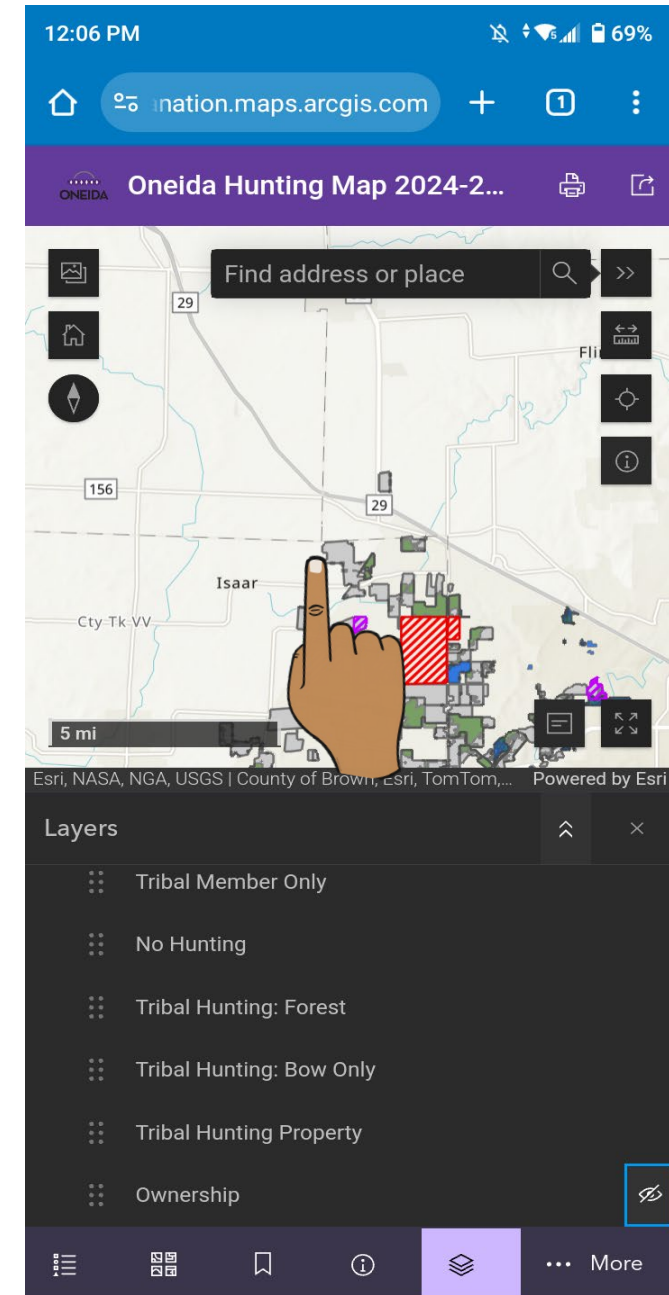
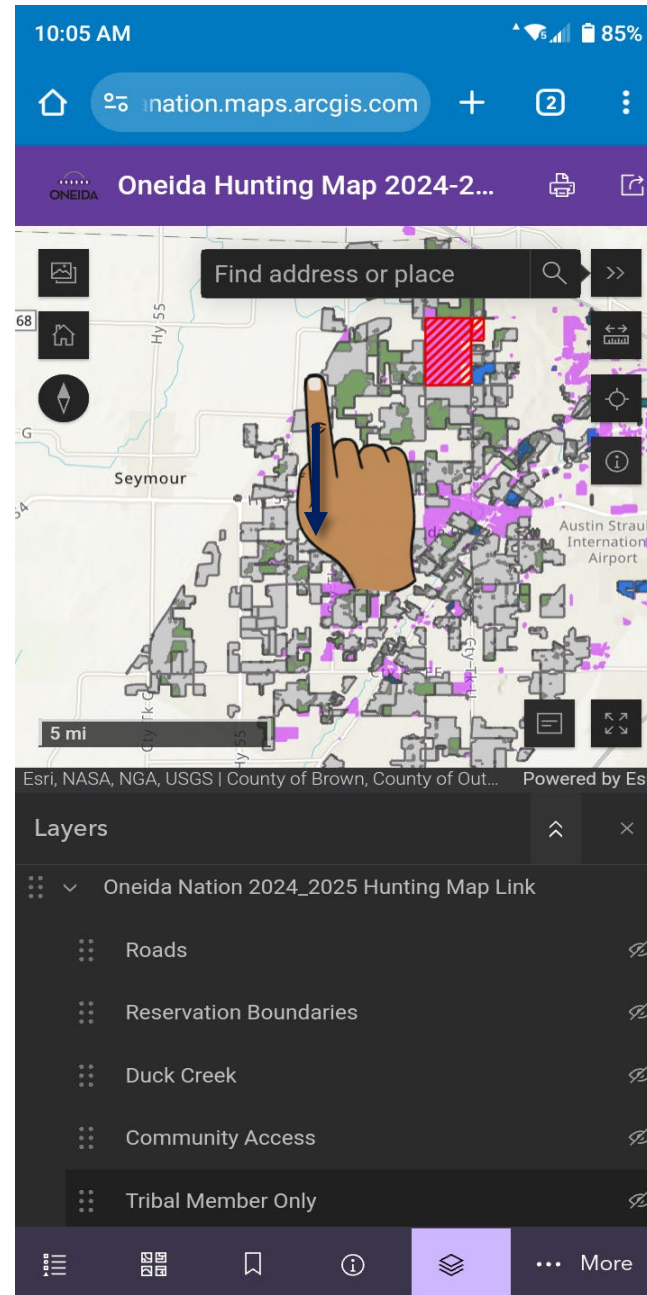


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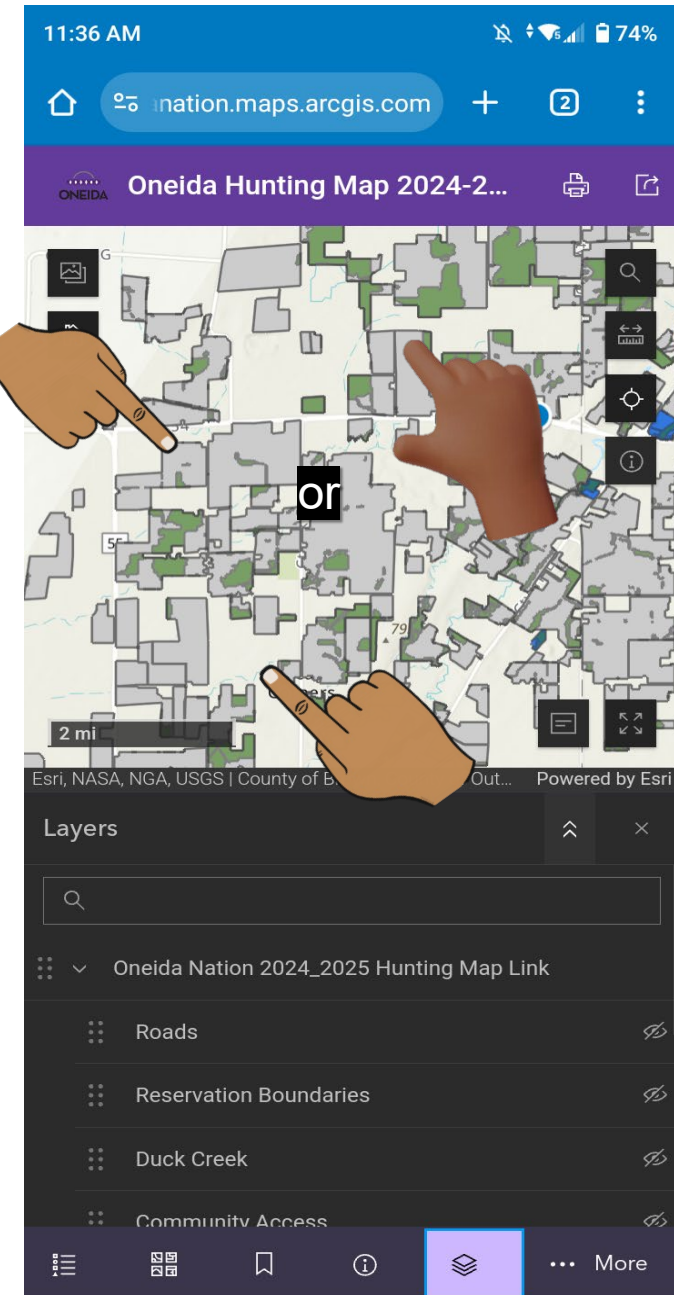
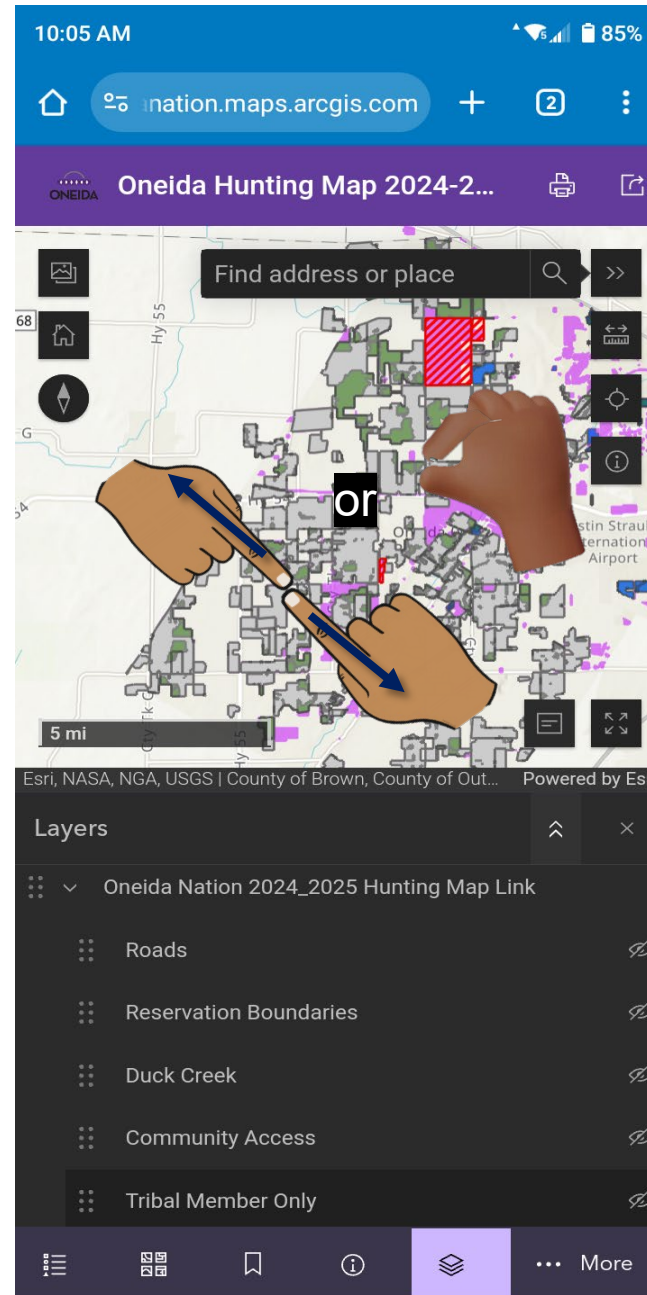
Exploring the Map

- You can move to different areas of the map by holding one finger down on the screen and moving it to a desired location



Exploring the Map

- You can zoom into the map by taking 2 fingers and pulling them away from each other

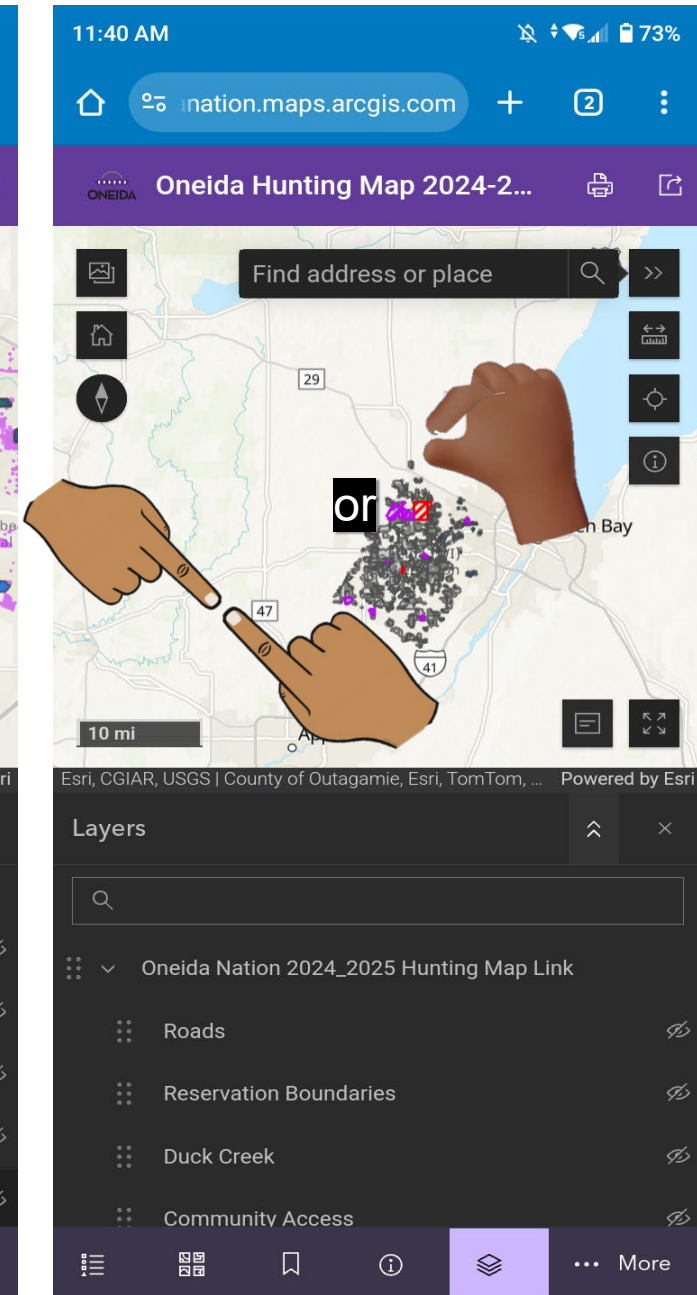
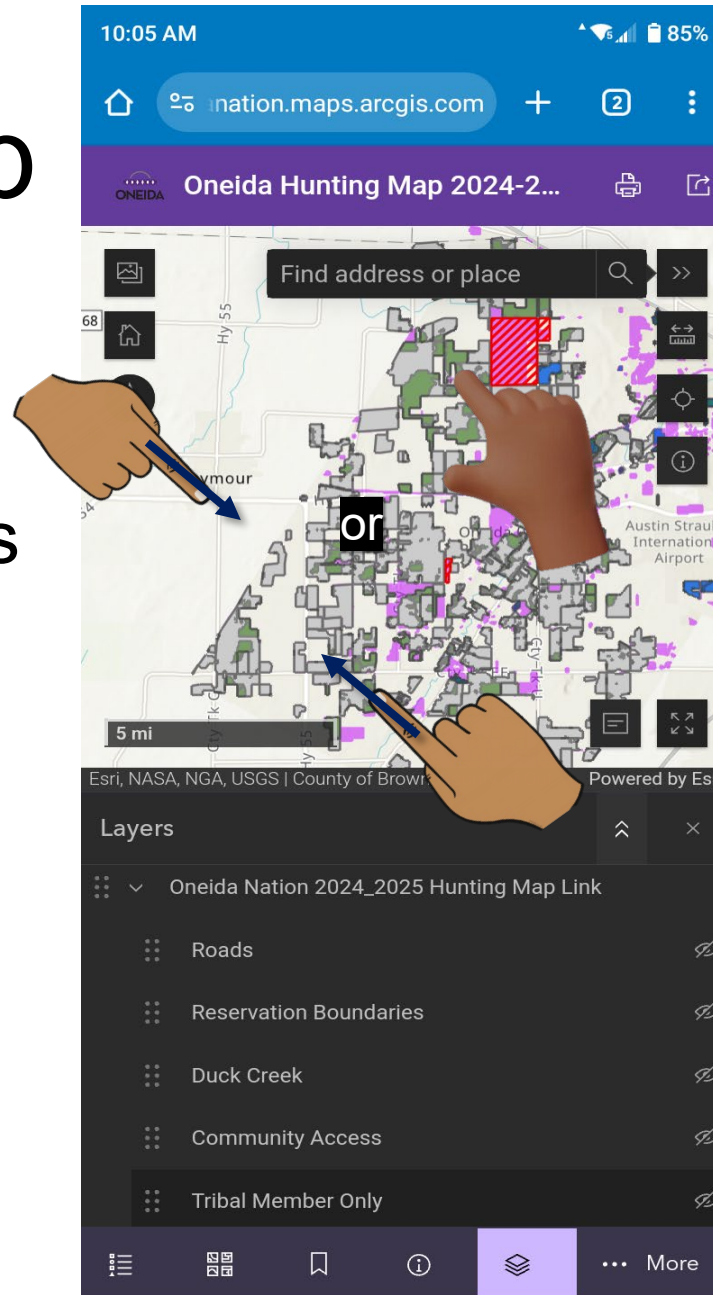


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Exploring the Map

- You can zoom out of the map by taking 2 fingers and bringing them towards each other

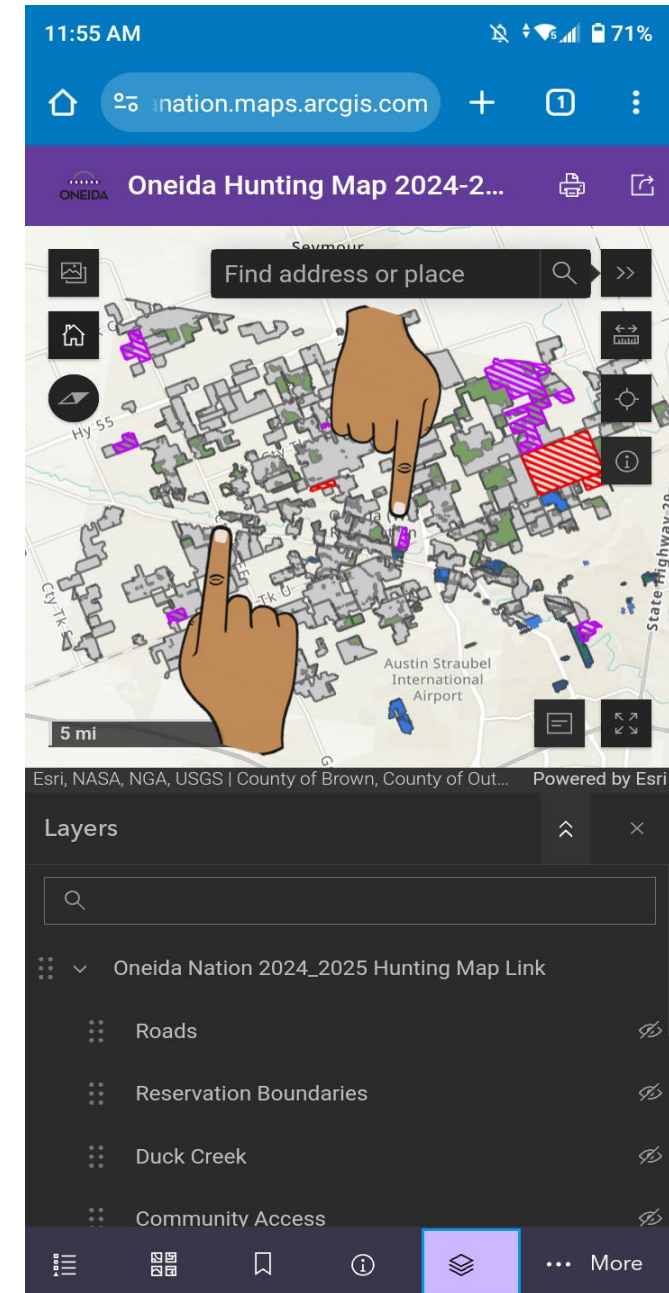
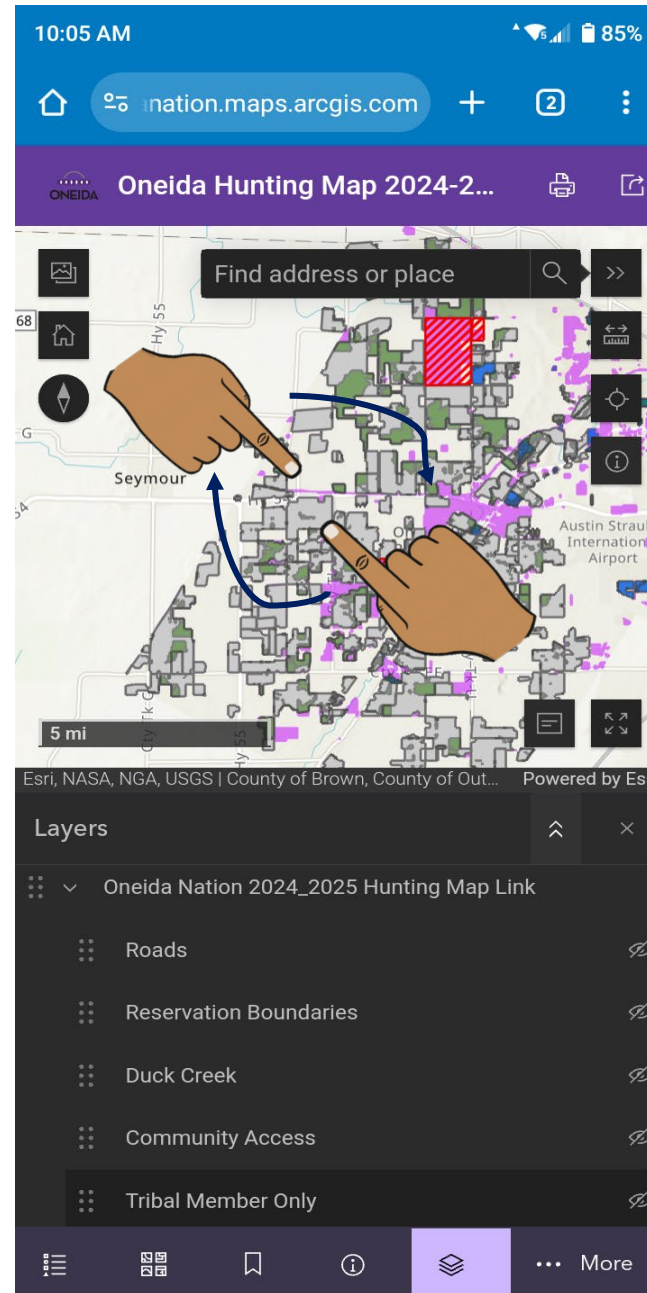


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Exploring the Map

- You can rotate the map by holding down 2 fingers and rotating the map in any direction



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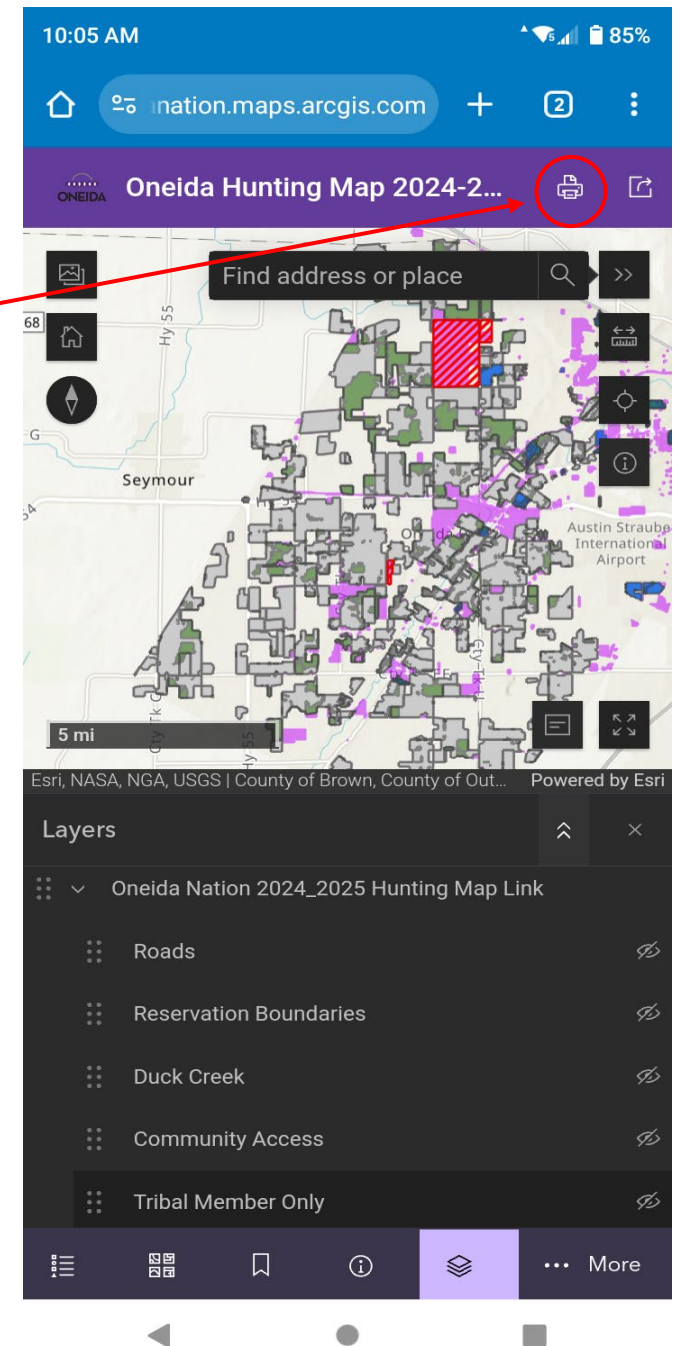
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Print or Export as a PDF



- This feature allows users to create a PDF version of the map that is currently displayed on their phone
- It can either be saved as a file on your phone, or printed to a connected printer



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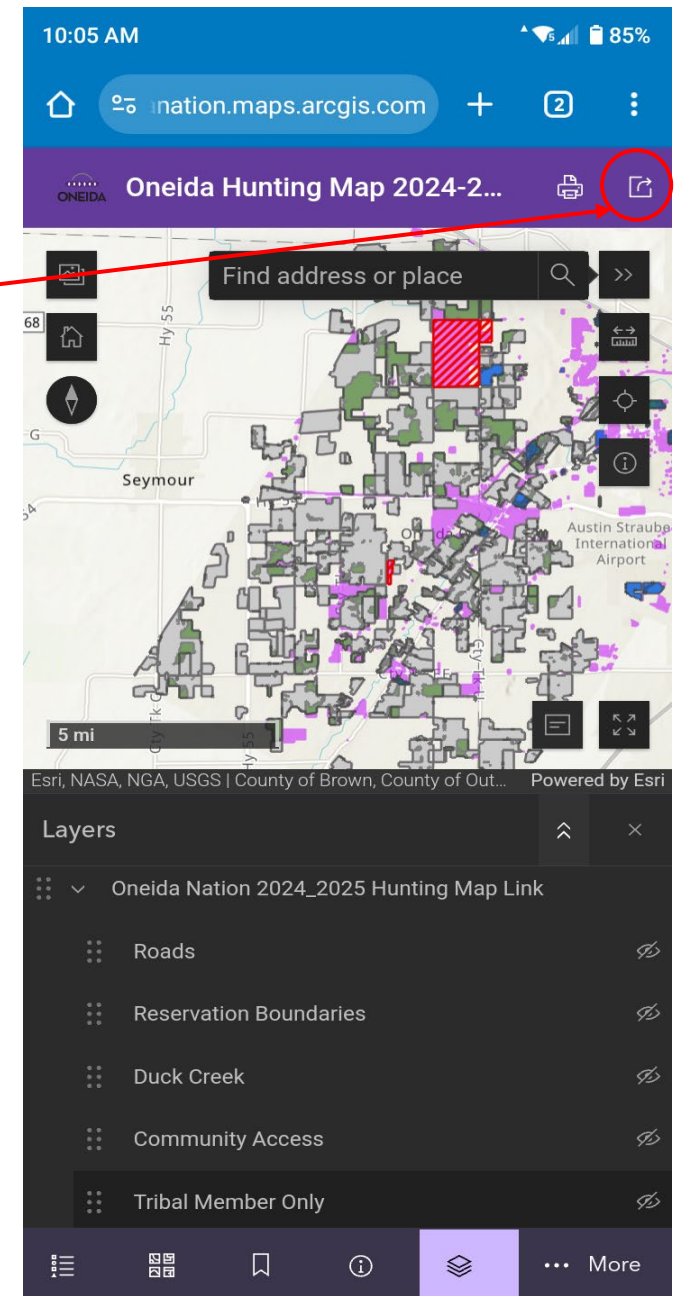
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Share



- This feature allows users to share the current map with other people
- This can be used to create a physical link (which can be copy and pasted), or it can upload the map directly to either Facebook, X (formally Twitter) or LinkedIn

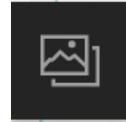


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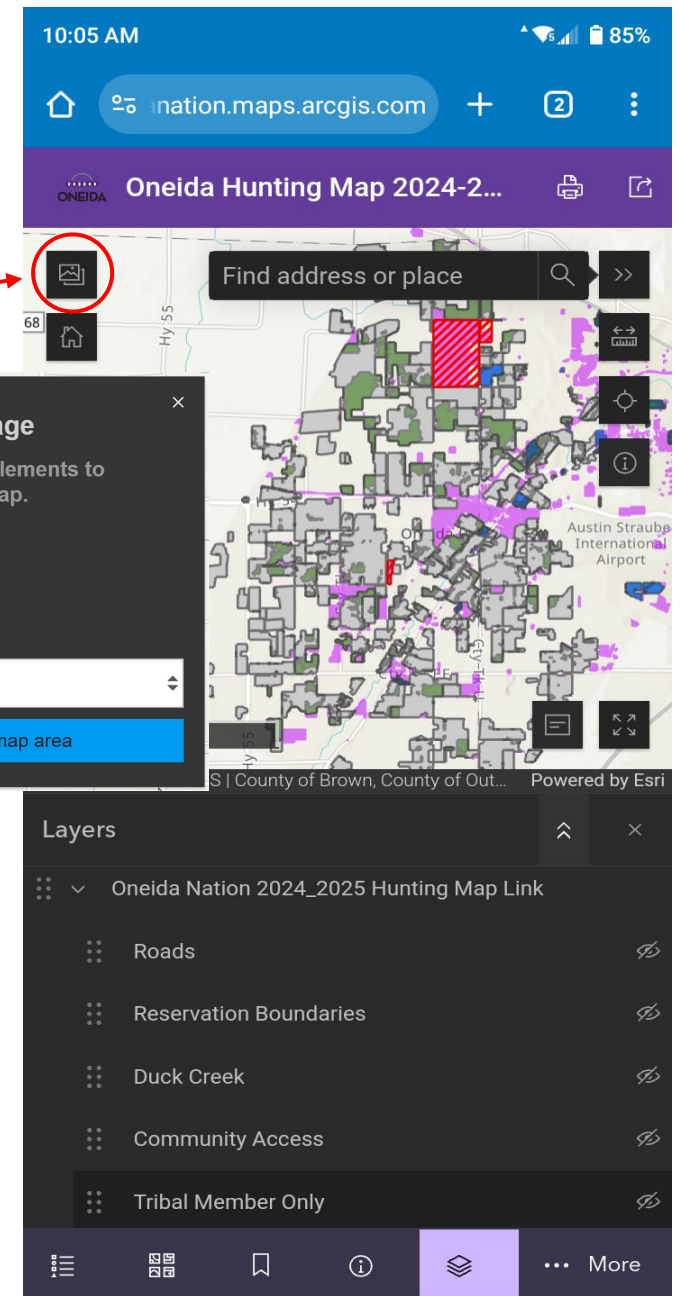

Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Capture an Image



- This feature allows users to take a specific portion of the map and save it as an image.
- Click on “Set the map area” then hold and drag your finger across your screen in the area you want to capture
- You can add and remove certain features, such as the map legend, by clicking the box next to the word
- Once done, click “Download image” to save the image to your phone



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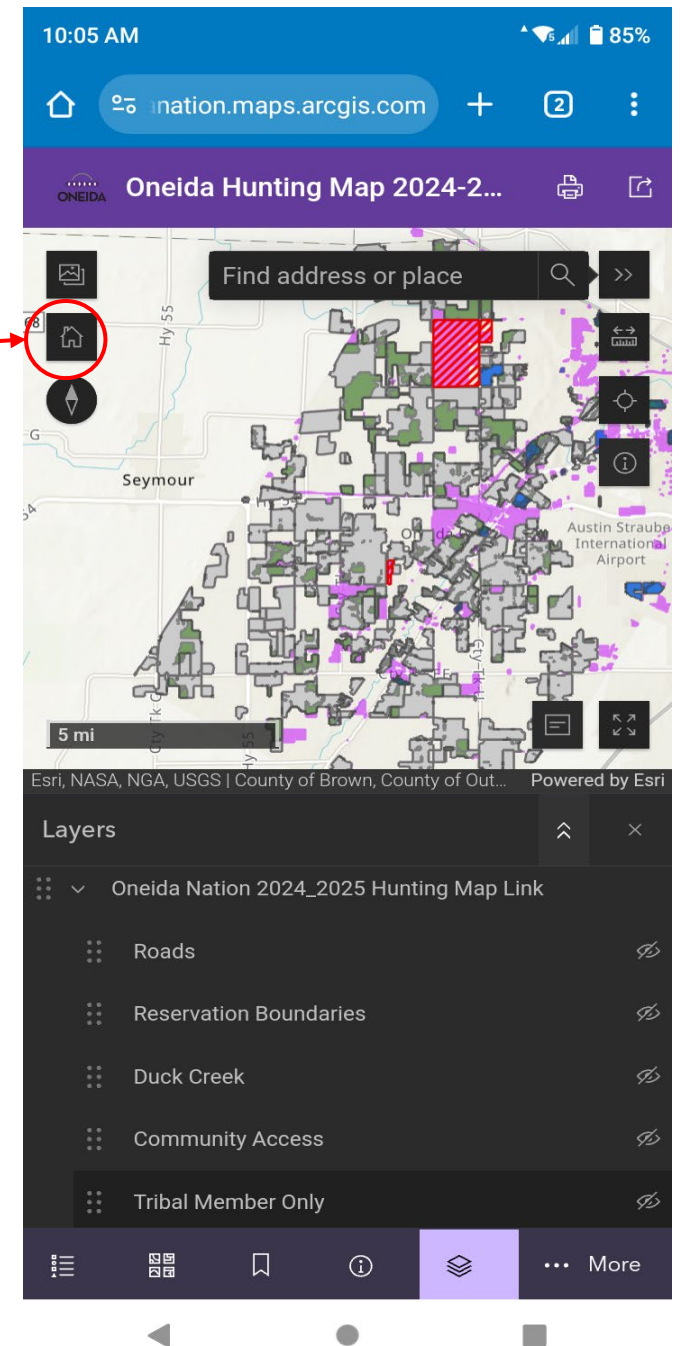
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Default map view



- This feature resets the map to the original view it was at when you first opened the website
- This feature is useful to reset your bearings if you zoomed in or out too far

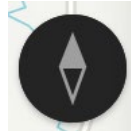


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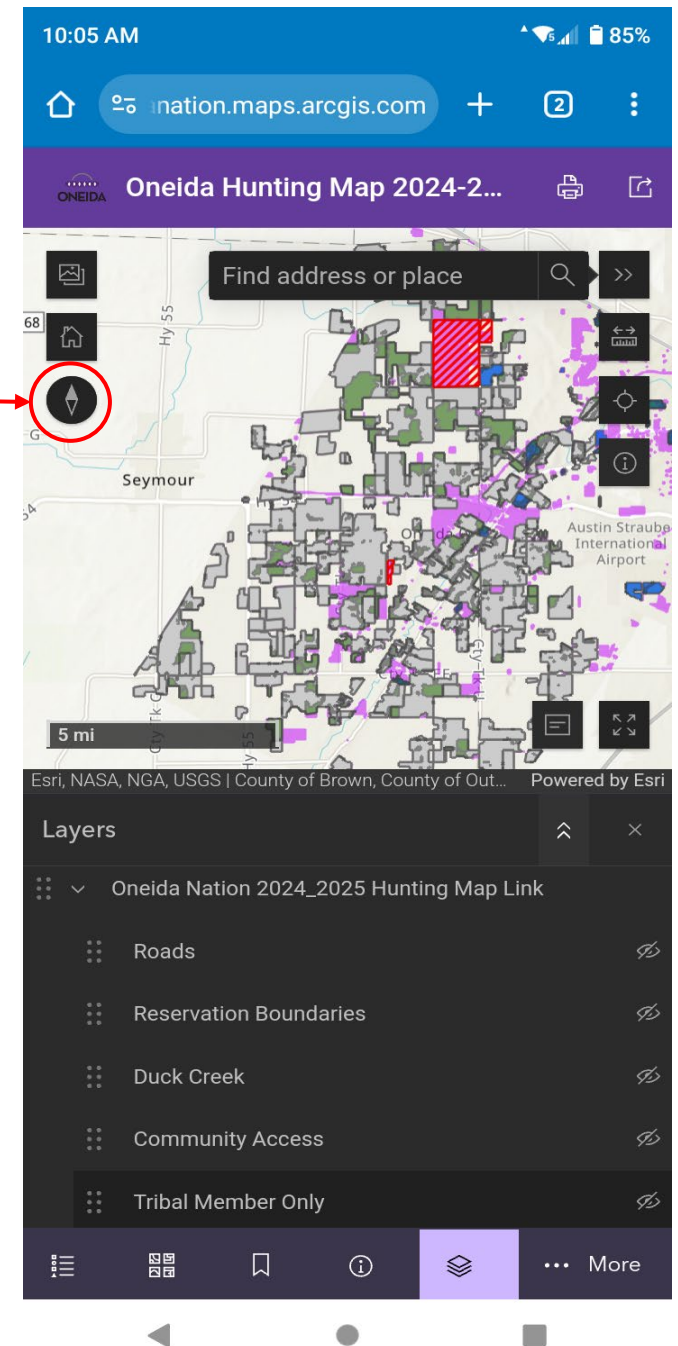
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Reset map orientation



- This feature resets the map so that the orientation is facing North
- Helpful to find your bearings if you rotated the map in any direction



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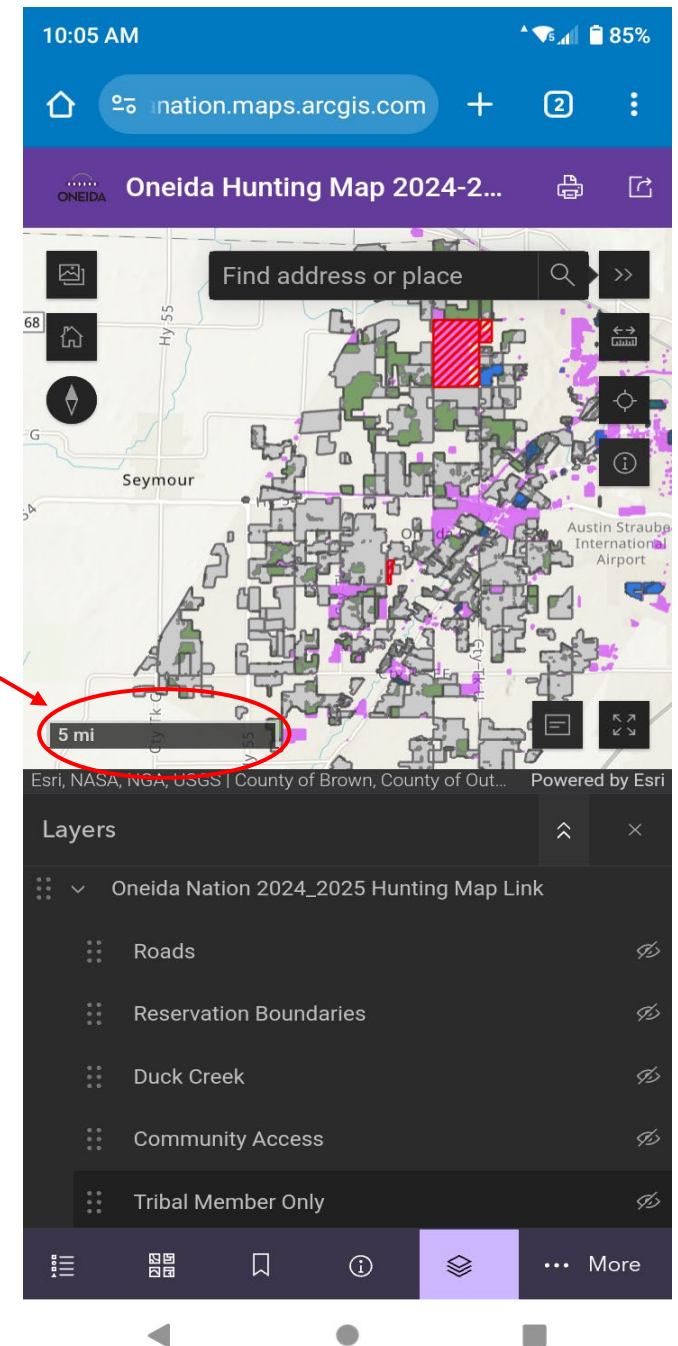

Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Map Scalebar




- This feature provides a proportional measurement of the map shown
- The distance automatically adjusts as you zoom in and out of the map.

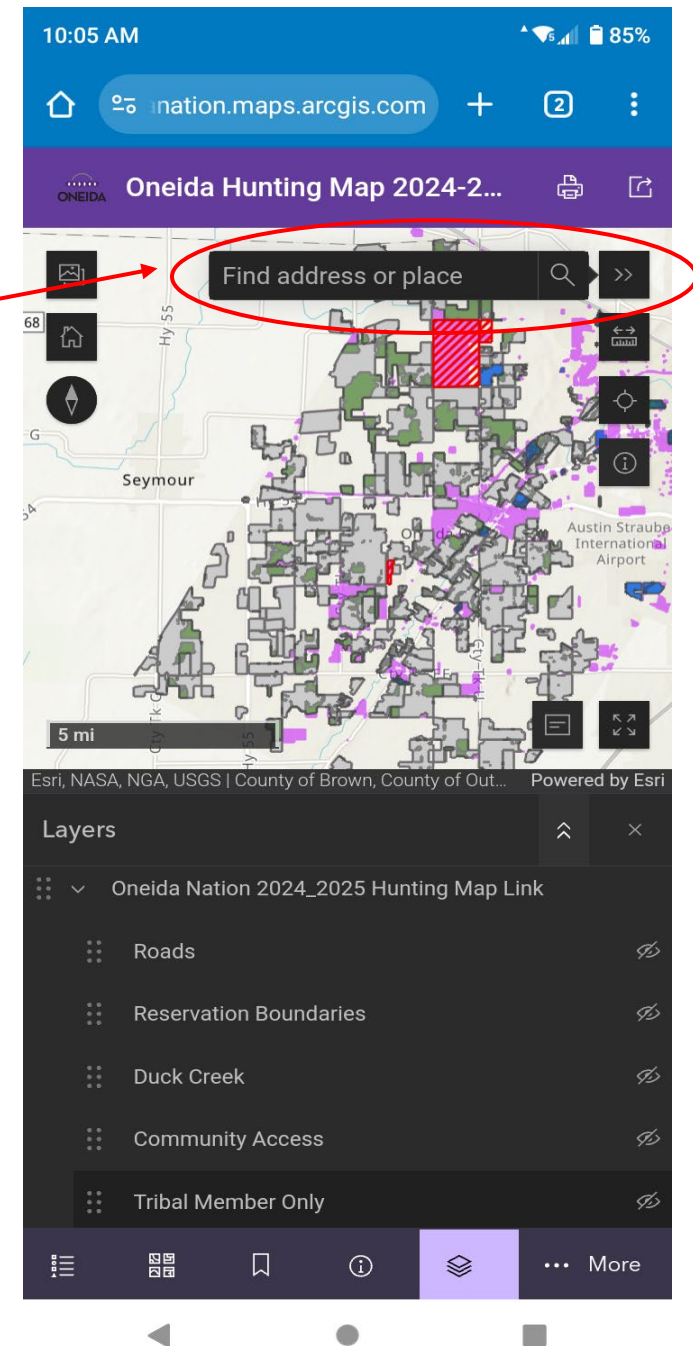


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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Find address or place 
- This feature allows users to type in a specific address or name of a well-known place
- The map will automatically zoom in to that address after clicking enter

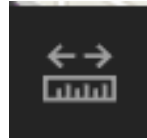


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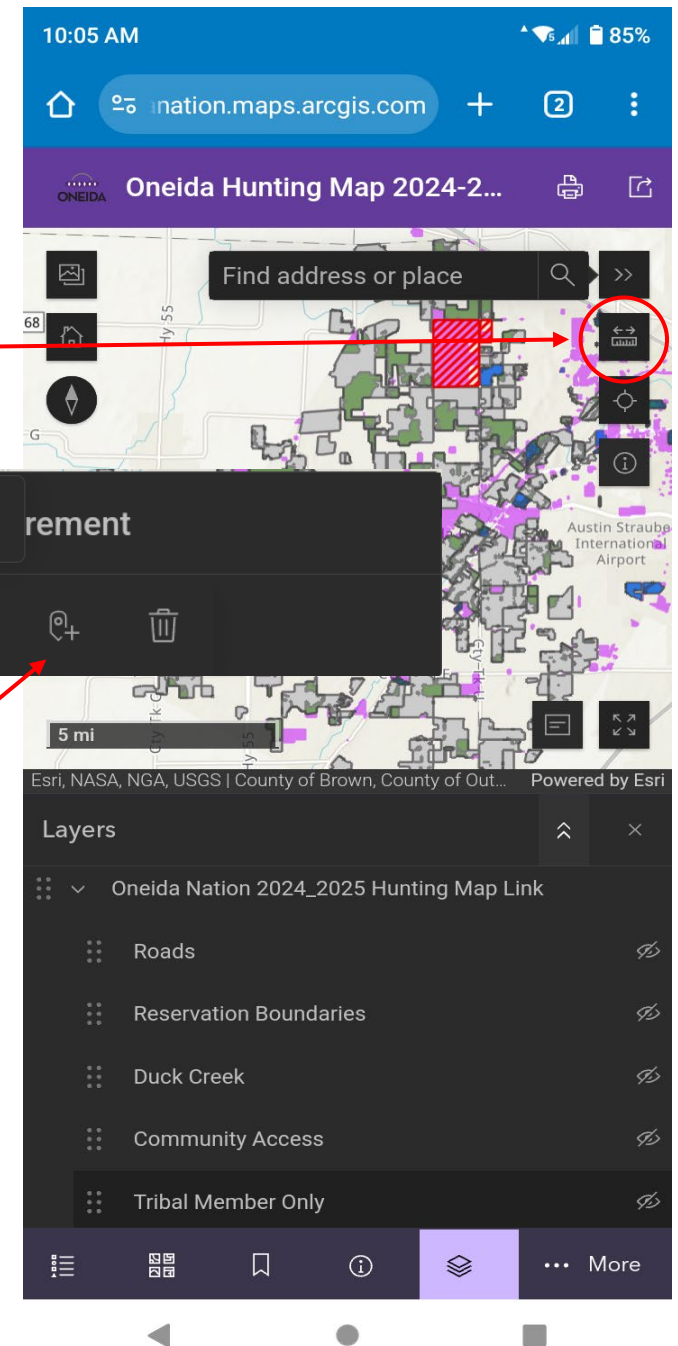
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Open Measurement



- This is a multi-option feature. It allows users to:
 - Measure the distance between 2 points
 - Measure the area of a polygon
 - Get an exact GPS coordinate of a location

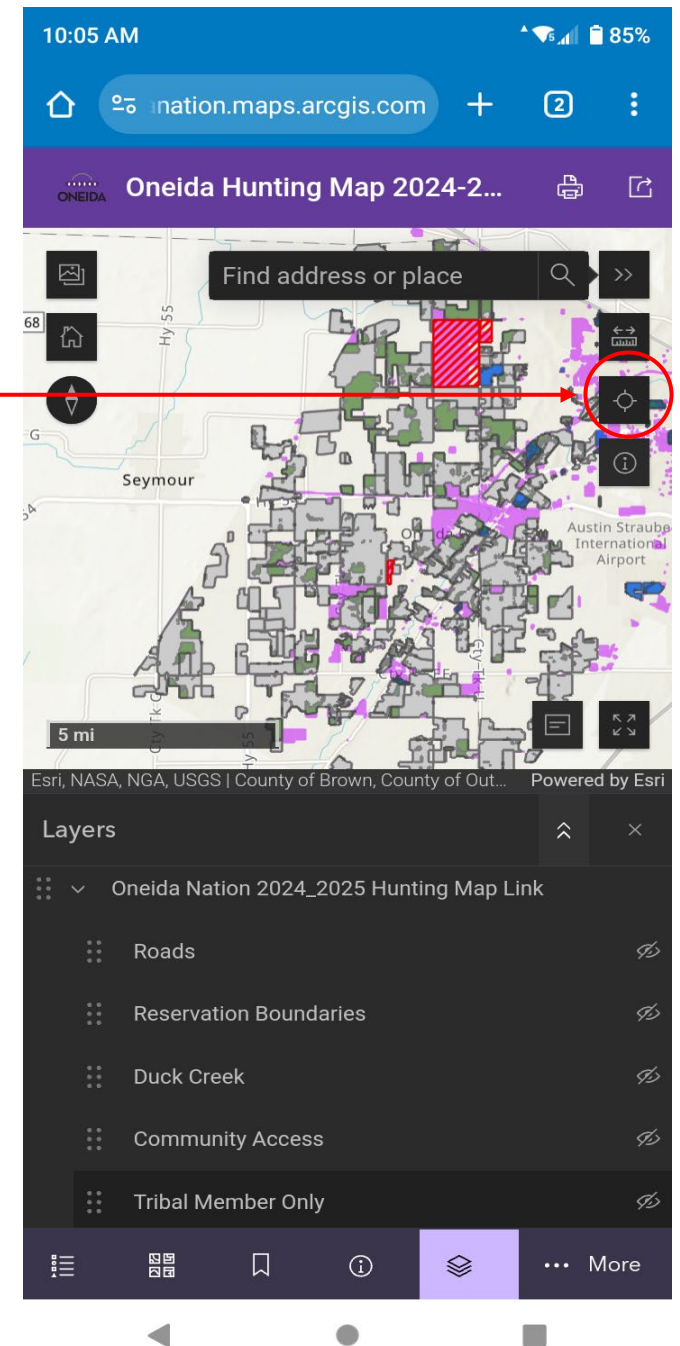


Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Find my location



- This feature will find where your current location is, and zoom into that spot on the map
- Must have location turned on in your phone settings

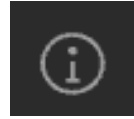


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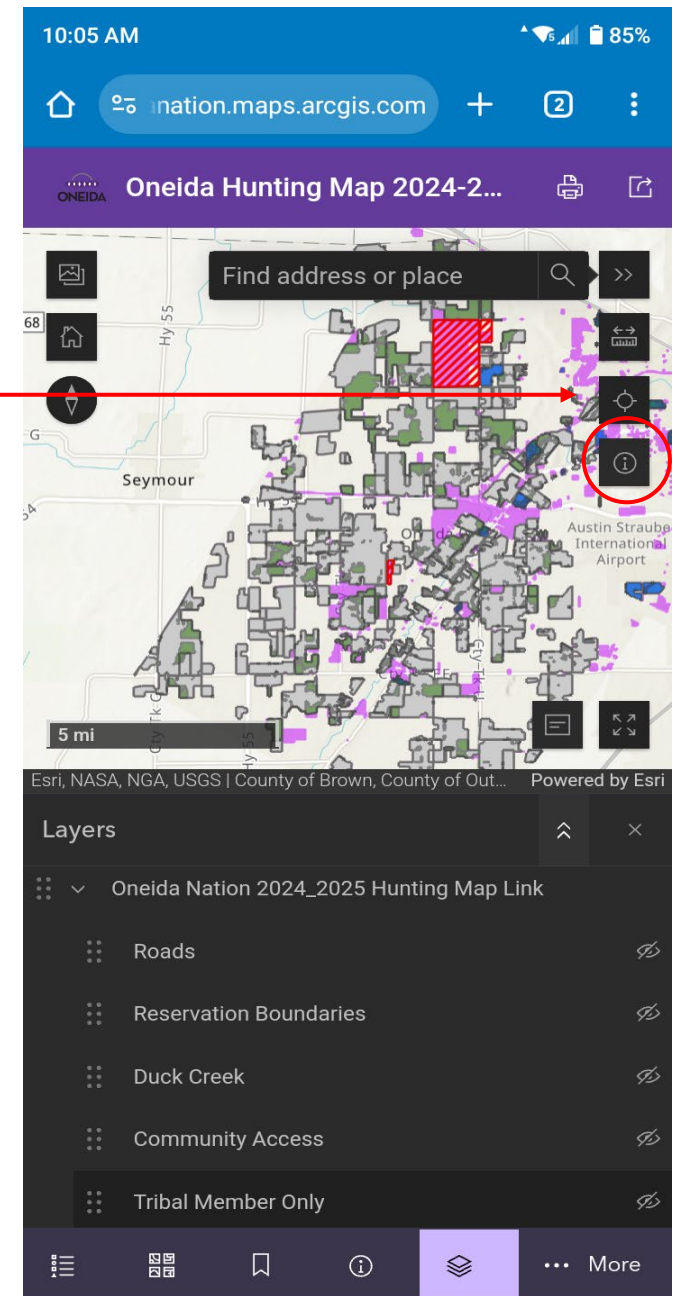
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Open introduction window



- This feature will re-open the information home screen you saw after clicking on the map link

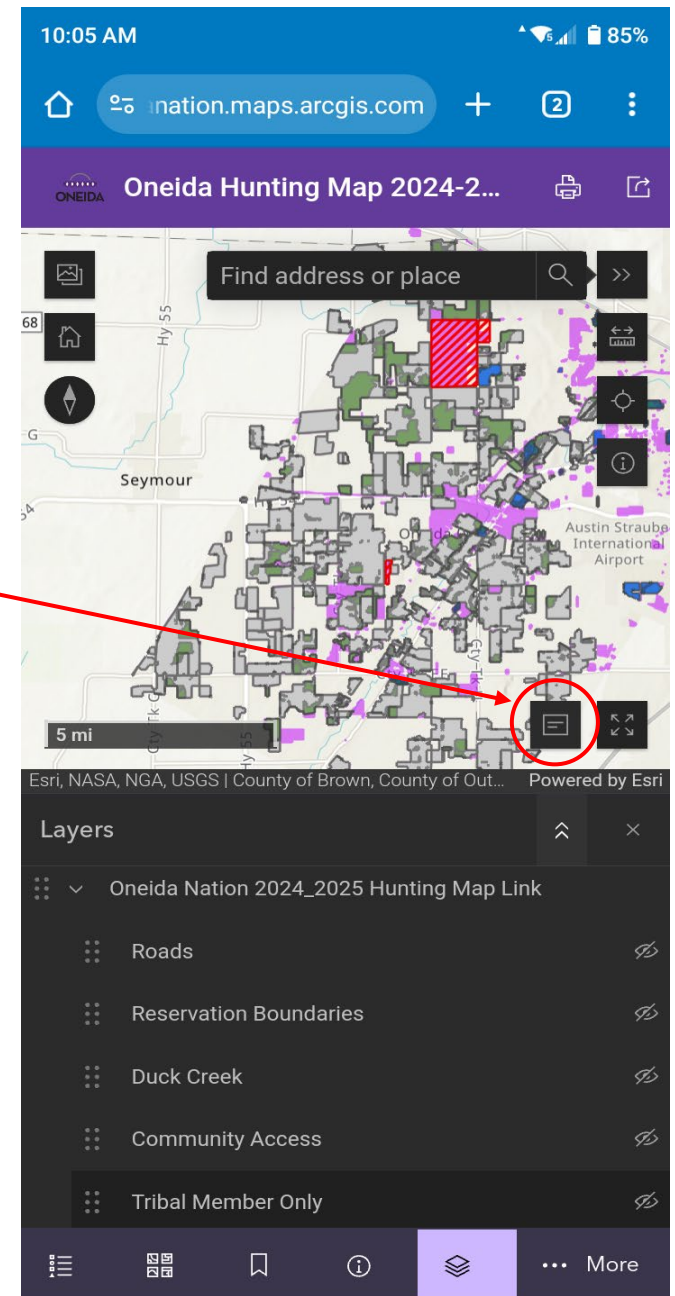


Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Cover page



- This feature will re-open the cover page home screen you saw immediately after clicking on the map link

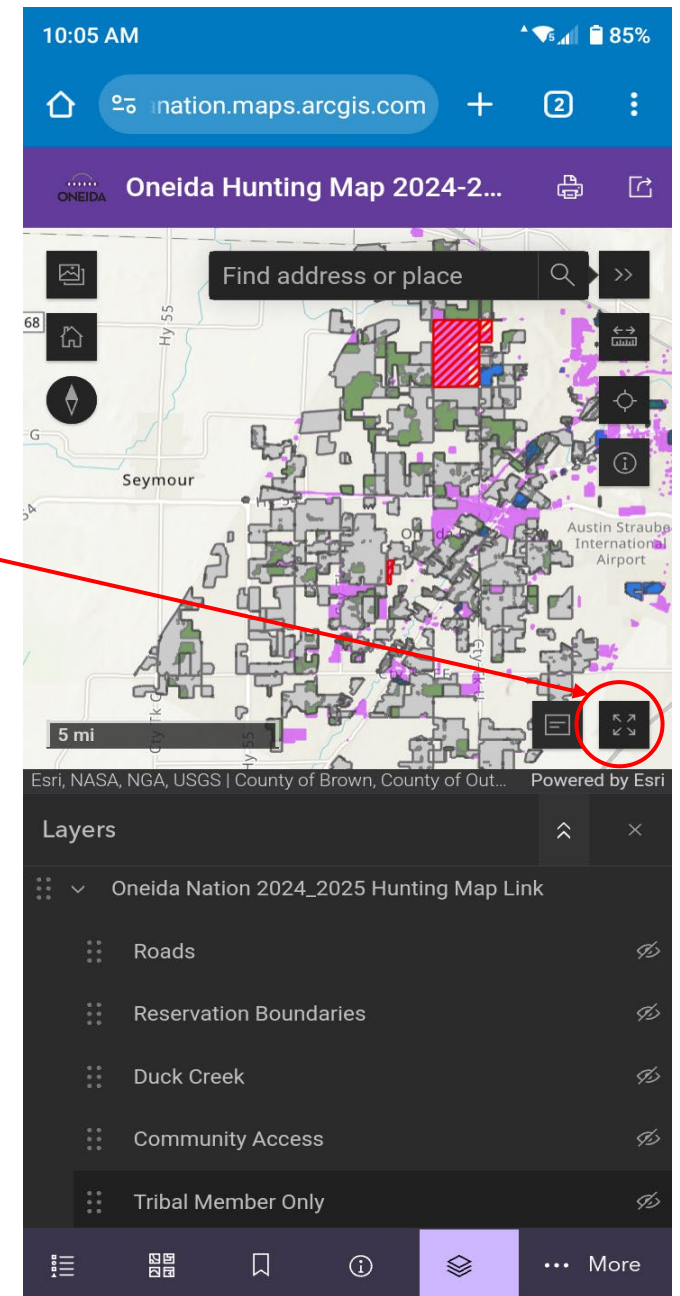
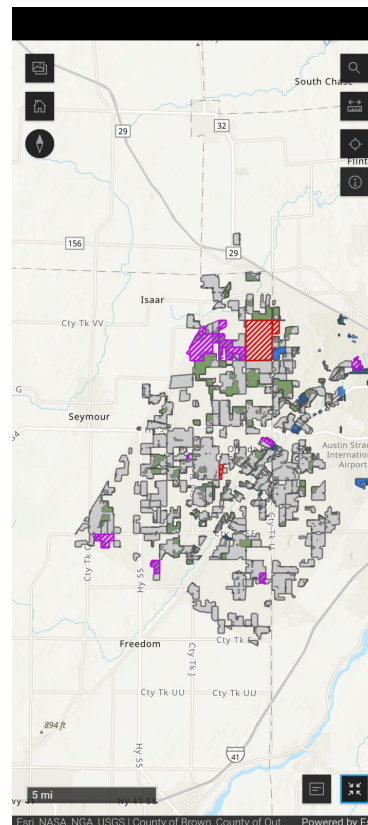


Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Enter fullscreen

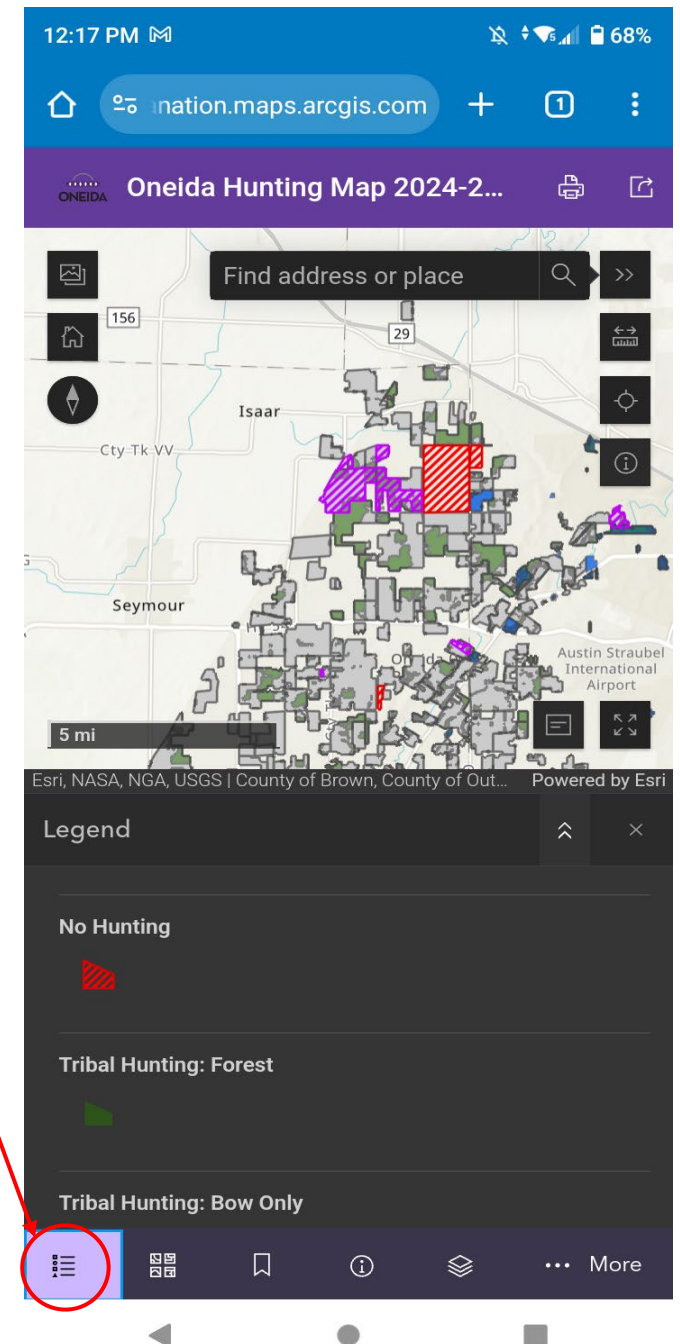


- This feature will fit the map to fill the entire area of your phone screen



Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Legend
 - The legend informs the map reader on what each unique value on the map represents.
 - For example, an area marked with red dashes means “No Hunting”



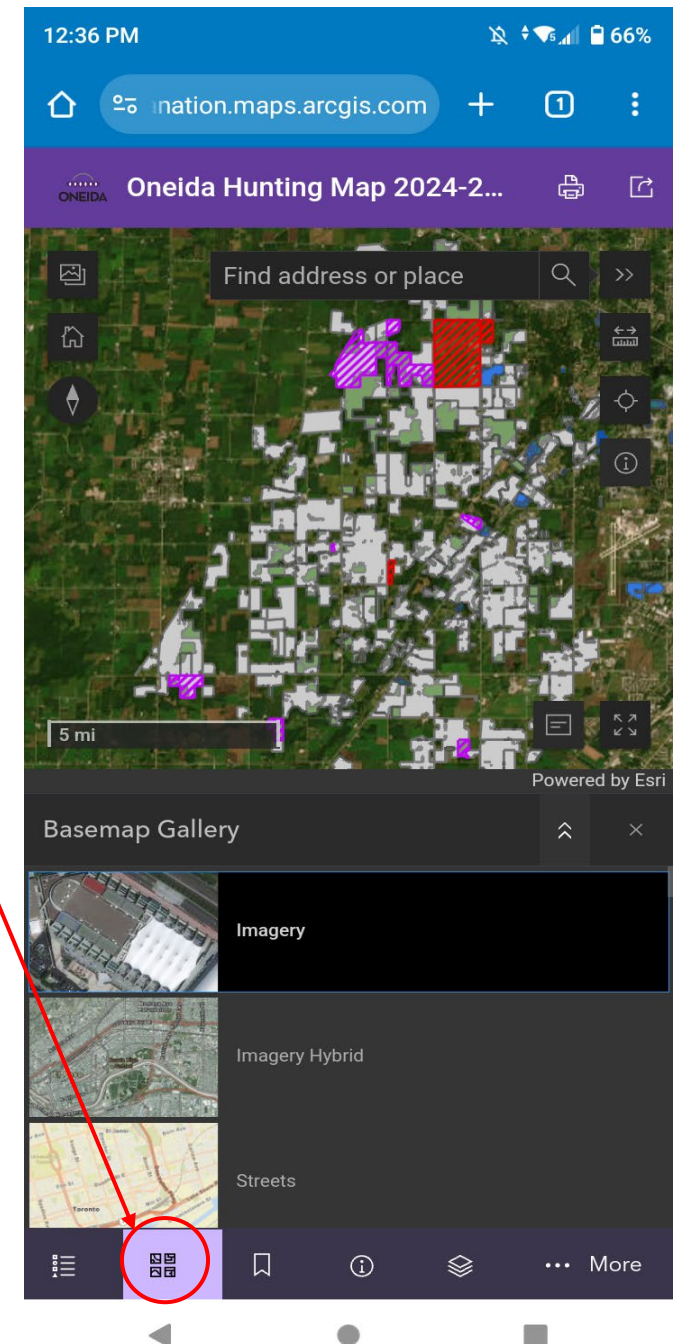
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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Basemap Gallery

- This feature allows you to change the map imagery
- For example, you can change the map background from classic map view to satellite imagery

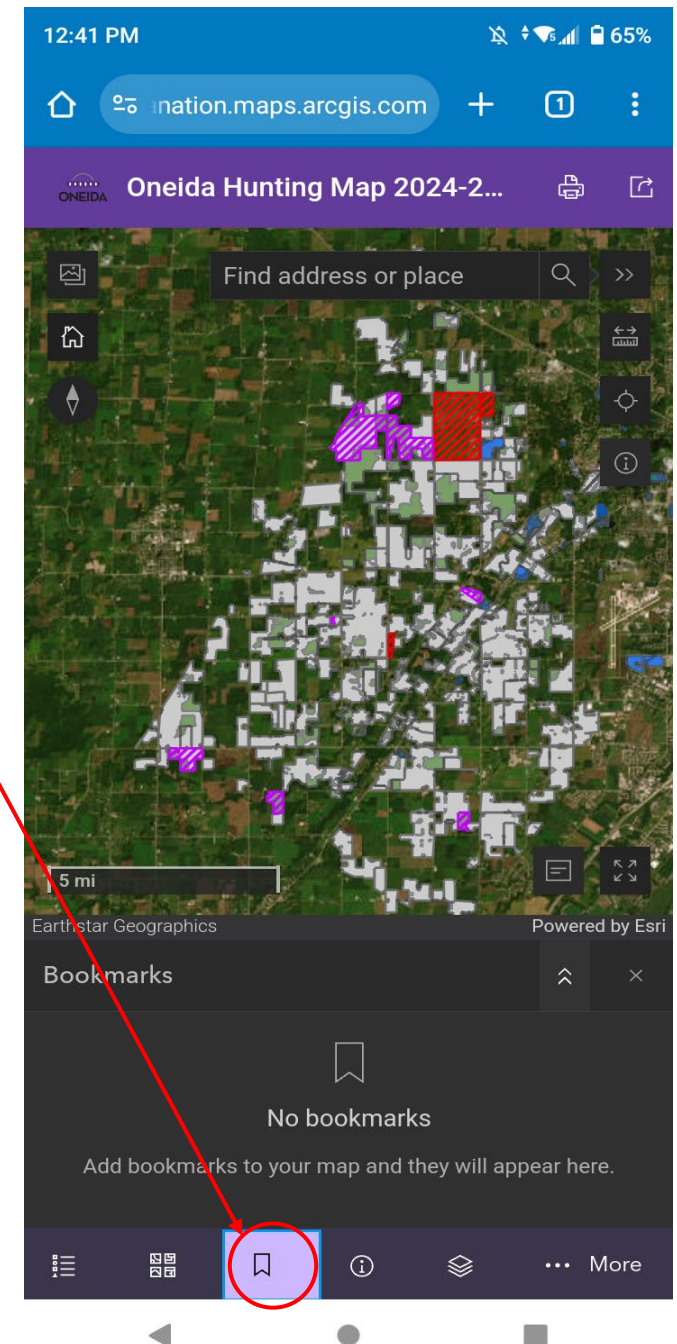


Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Bookmarks



- This tab is where all your map bookmarks can be found
- Bookmarks are used to save a certain area on the map, and helps you re-find them later without having to start all over
- This feature is still in development

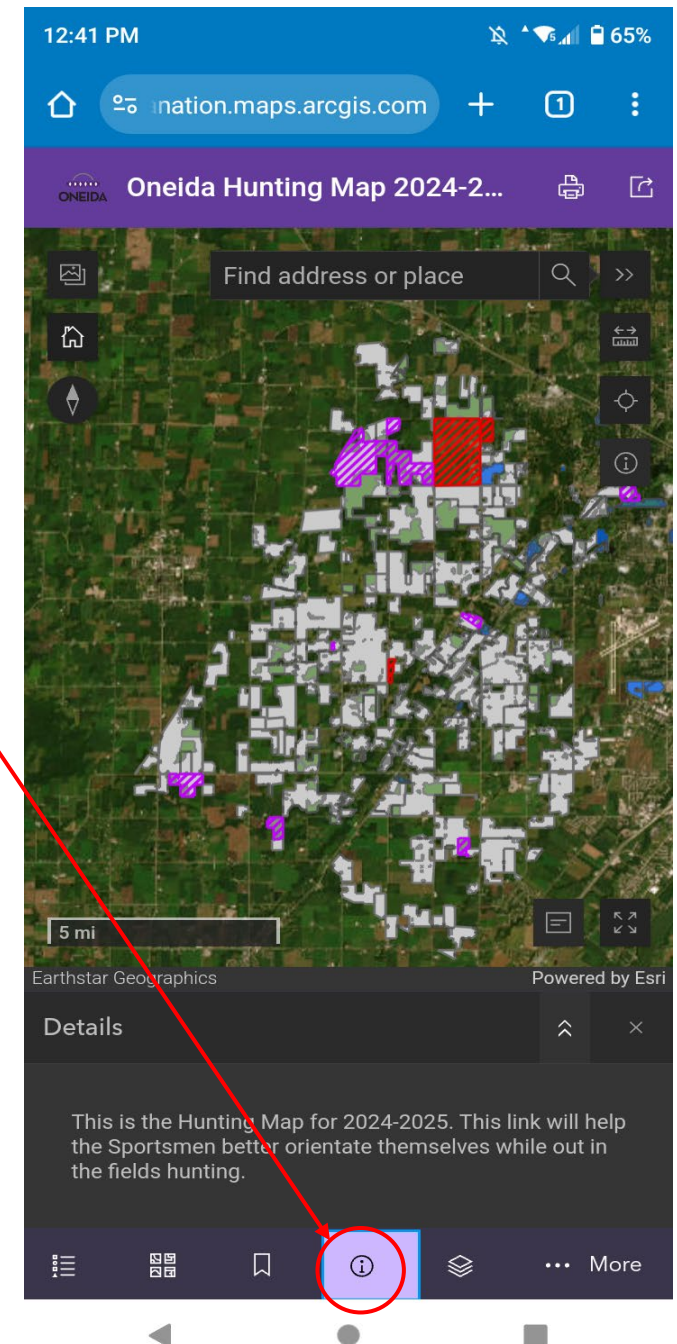


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Parts and Features of the Base Map

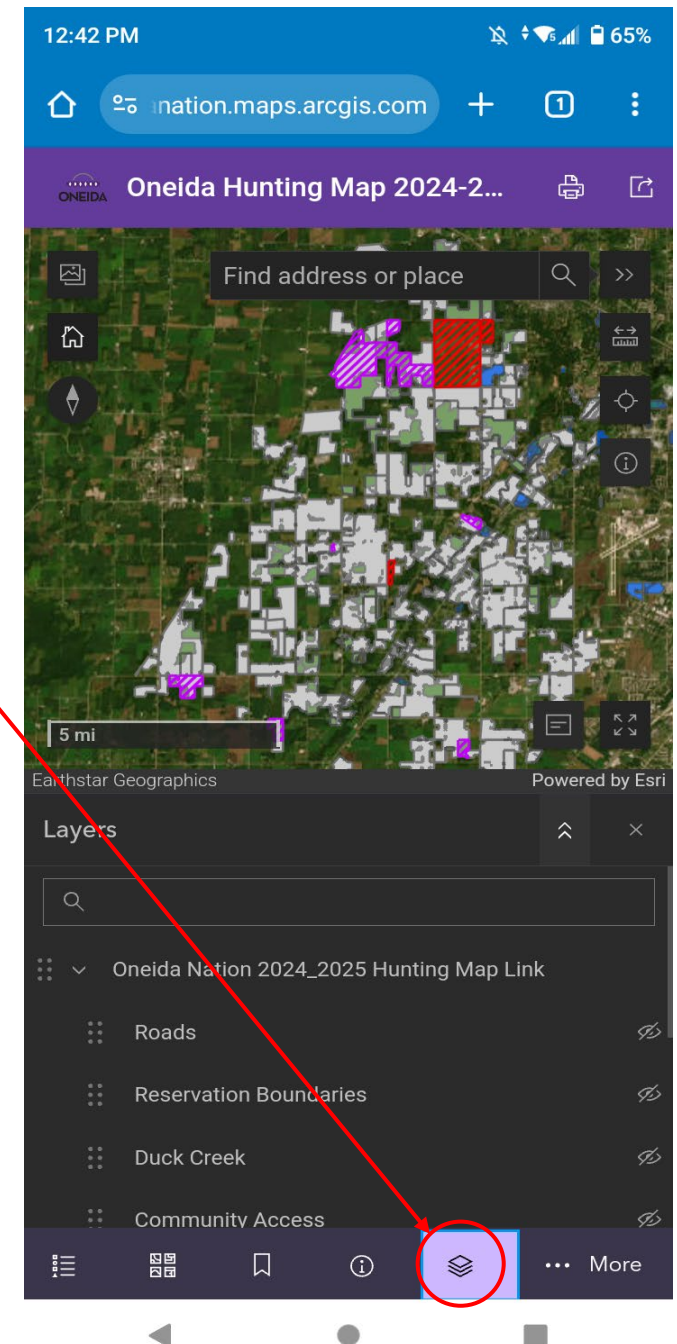
- Details
 - This tab will show the map description WITHOUT bringing up the homescreen



Parts and Features of the Base Map

- Layers

- This tab allows the user to customize what data they're able to see projected on the map
- For example, if you only want to know where tribal bow hunting is allowed, you can turn off all layers except for "Tribal Hunting: Bow Only" to see only the areas where bow hunting is allowed



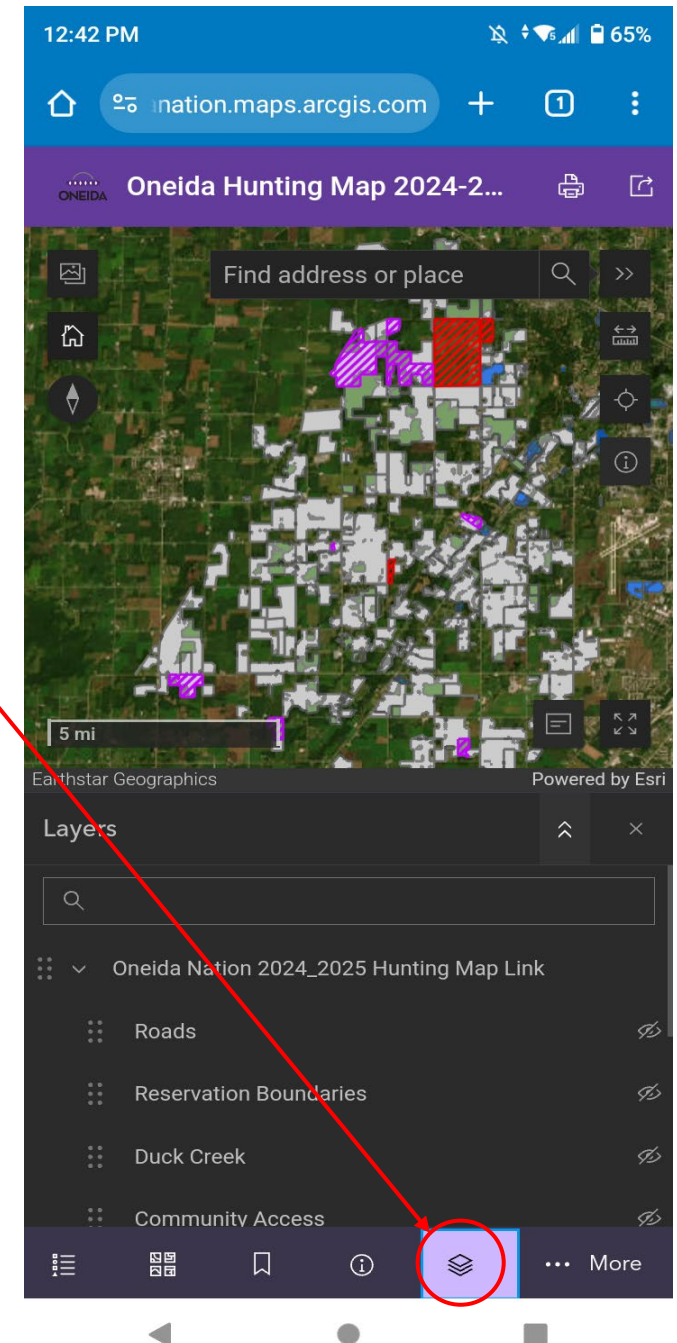

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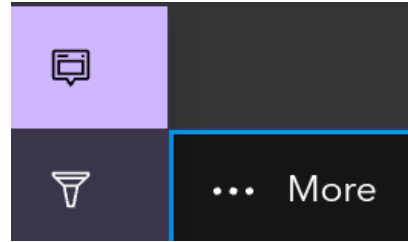


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Parts and Features of the Base Map

- More



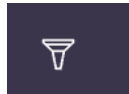
- This tab contains 2 additional tabs nested inside of it

- Info

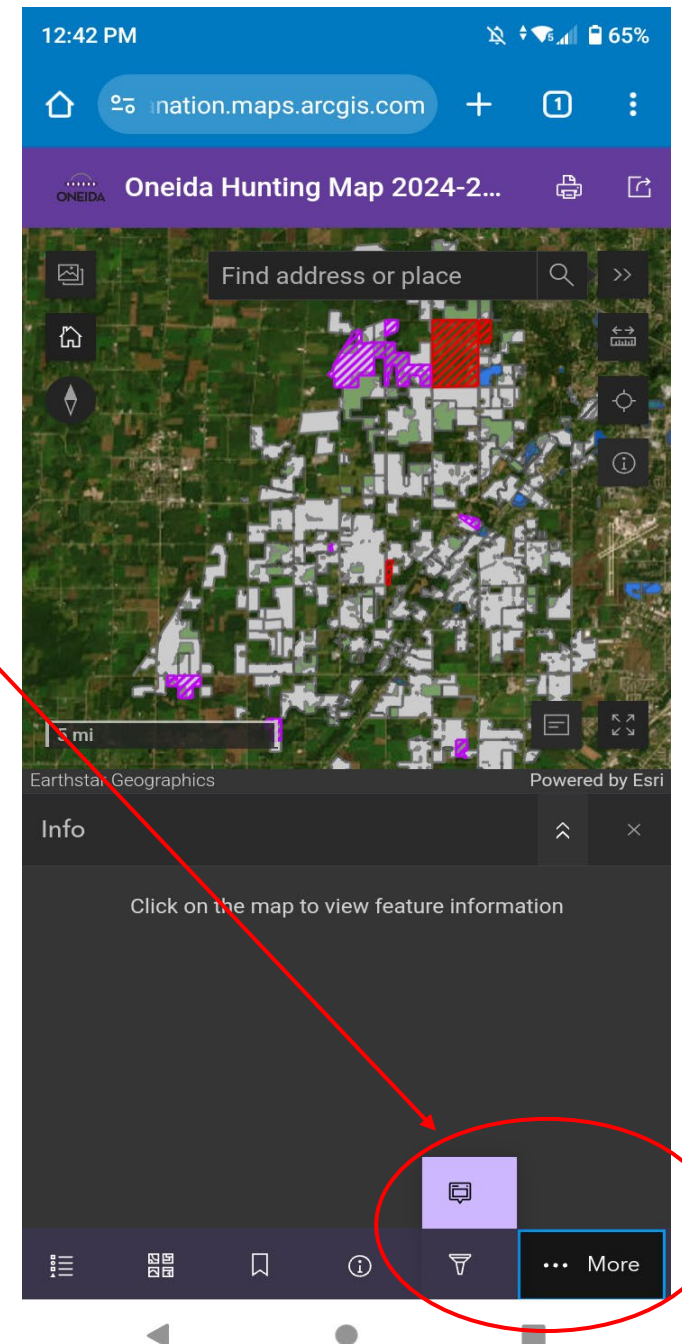


- This tab brings up all recorded data uploaded about a certain area. Click on a specific location to pull up that information

- Filter



- This tab allows user to filter what information is shown on the map. Allows user to find certain areas easier
- This feature is still in development
