Below are some updates about Cobell Scholarship opportunities and initiatives that we encourage you to share with your contacts and communities:

Cobell Fellowships

Elouise Dissertation Writing-Year Fellowship

The 2025/2026 application is open through **January 10, 2025**. This fellowship supports American Indian and Alaska Native doctoral scholars with a stipend of up to \$30,000 for a dissertation writing year.

Graduate Summer Research Fellowship

The 2025 application is open through **January 10, 2025**. Awards support American Indian and Alaska Native graduate scholars with a stipend of up to \$5,000 for summer research.

Academic Year Cobell Scholarship Opportunities

Applications for the **2024/2025 Academic Year Undergraduate and Graduate Cobell Scholarships** opened on **December 15, 2024** and will close **March 31, 2025**. Award amounts include:

- **Undergraduate scholarships: Up to \$5,000 per academic year**
- **Graduate scholarships: Up to \$12,500 per academic year**

Vocational Scholarship Opportunity

Applications for the **Vocational Scholarship** is open year-round to scholars entering or currently pursuing a vocational certificate or degree program.

Each application cycle begins **May 1** for scholars beginning in **June**. Awards up to \$5,000 per year are offered on a rolling basis depending on the start date. The Summer Vocational Scholarship is a separate award.
