Project Description:

The proposed project would provide a centrally located community recreation complex which supports the social, cultural, physical, and recreational needs of the Oneida Community. The project that will address a holistic approach to providing community recreational and social programing. The facility will consist of: aquatics, aerobics, gymnasiums, fitness and body building, youth learning and activity components, arts and craft center, events areas, outdoor sports fields and ropes course.

The project is being coordinated with CDC #13-011 Oneida Nation High School with the intention that they will share a site/campus.

The proposed project would be a building of 132,201 square feet. The site analysis for the campus determined a need for 50 to 60 acres of property.

Current Status:

- The project team is re-evaluating the Recreational Space Programming needs and updating the Project Budget Estimate accordingly.
- A communication overview plan has been developed with Oneida Nation High School which includes project information and is available to the community.
- The CDC Approval Package is complete:
 - ♦ GSD Director has approved the package.
 - \diamond OBC has approved the project.
- GSD and General Manager continue to develop and implement various communication efforts seeking community input before presentation to GTC.
