## **Wind Chill Timeline**

### **Saturday Night - Wednesday Morning**

### **Key Messages**

- An arctic airmass will bring bitter cold temperatures and dangerously cold wind chills late Saturday-early Wednesday.
- Although the airmass is abnormal for this time of year, air temperatures will not be nearing/ threatening records.

### **Impacts**

- Wind chills this cold can cause frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 20 minutes.
- Pipes may be prone to freezing/bursting.
- Outdoor pets/livestock put at risk.








# Forecast Minimum Wind Chills

**Monday Morning (Left) and Tuesday Morning (Right)** 









# **Criteria: Cold Weather Headlines**

Minimize time outdoors.

Limit outside time & keep them bundled up.



Insulate pipes if possible.

Open up sink cabinets to expose pipes to heated air.

Disconnect hoses & turn off water to sprinklers.
