FAQs for Virtual GTC Prep Meetings

1. Who can attend the Virtual GTC Prep meetings?

• The meetings are exclusively for Oneida tribal members.

2. Is there a stipend for attending the meetings?

• No, there is no stipend provided for attending these meetings.

3. How are the meetings conducted?

• The meetings are held virtually on Microsoft Teams.

4. How do I sign up for the meetings?

• You can sign up for the meetings through our members-only site in the GTC Portal.

5. What do I need to participate in the meetings?

 You will need a stable internet connection, a computer or a smartphone with Microsoft Teams installed, and the email containing the link to the meeting.

6. Can I join the meeting if I am late?

• Yes, you can join the meeting at any time, but it is recommended to join on time to not miss any important information.

7. Will the meetings be recorded?

• Yes, the meetings will be recorded and made available on the members-only site for those who cannot attend live.

8. How can I ask questions during the meeting?

 You can ask questions using the chat feature in Microsoft Teams or by raising your hand virtually during the meeting.

9. Who can I contact for technical support?

• For technical support, please contact our call center at (920) 869-4481 and they will connect you with our meeting administrator.

10. What topics will be covered in the prep meetings?

 The meetings will cover various topics relevant to GTC, including an agenda review, procedures, and any other pertinent information.

11. Do I need to register for each meeting separately?

• For now, you need to register for each meeting individually through the members-only site. This will likely change in the near future.

12. How can I provide feedback about the meetings?
