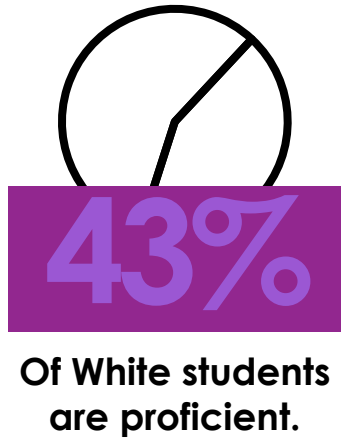
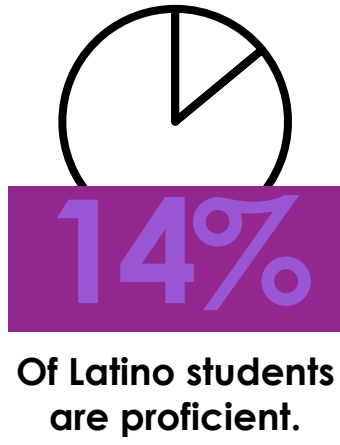
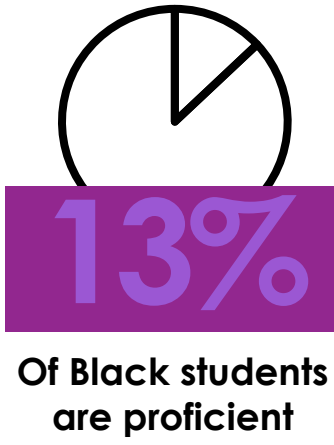

5% of Native kids in Brown County are proficient readers in 3rd grade

44% Of Native students in Brown County are chronically absent



Large equity gaps exist for Native students in Brown County

38% 3rd grade reading equity gap between White students (43%) and Native students

37% Chronic absenteeism equity gap between White students (7%) and Native students (44%)

Students who aren't proficient in reading by grade 3 are **four times less likely to graduate high school** than proficient readers. (Education Week)



Reading proficiency = the percentage of 3rd grade students who scored proficient or advanced on the Wisconsin Forward Exam in English Language Arts 2021/2022

Chronic absenteeism = the percentage of K – 12th grade students in Brown County who missed 10% or more of the school year in the 2020/2021 school year
