#### **Pet Licenses FAQ**

## > Are pet licenses required?

 Yes, the Oneida Nation Domestic Animals Law states an owner shall be required to obtain a license for any dog or cat five (5) months of age or older on an annual basis.



# When does a pet license expire?

The license year starts on January 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on December 31<sup>st</sup> of every year. So pet licenses expire every year on December 31<sup>st</sup>. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required to get a pet license. Since rabies vaccinations expire, pet licenses must be renewed each year to ensure rabies vaccination is maintained.
