OUR HISTORY

AJRCCC opened its doors to the Oneida Community in 1978 and was originally named Oneida Nursing Home. It was later renamed Anna John Nursing Home in honor of a community member named Anna John, who played an integral role in it's establishment, along with Amelia Cornelius, Audrey Doxtator, Joycelyn Ninham, and Priscilla Manders. It was the first tribally owned nursing home!

In 2013, the AJRCCC opened it's doors to replace AJNH. It was designed with state of the art technology to assist with improved quality of life!

In 2015, AJRCCC became certified by the Veterans Administration- qualified Veterans can be admitted to our facility in the same manner as any VA long term care facility! AJRCCC was the first Native owned VA certfied long-term care facility in the nation!




