

CDC # 13-011 - Oneida Nation High School

Project Description:

The proposed project is to remove the current Oneida Nation High School (ONHS) academic program from its location within the Norbert Hill Center into a new facility. A new school would provide the opportunity for improved educational programs which would attract a larger student body and expand the learning experience. The Nation's goal is to provide a safe, functional learning environment that serves as the foundation for a quality educational experience of all students, families and the Oneida Community. ^yehya?tuhs kayntehlihake "Someone will be educated".

The project is being coordinated with CDC #16-011 Oneida Recreation Complex with the intention that they will share a site/campus.

The proposed project would be a building of 110,772 square feet. The site analysis for the campus determined a need for 50 to 60 acres of property.

Current Status:

- The Project client is working to report out quarterly until the analysis of the 9/8/24 GTC motion comments are completed, and until the project is ready to be presented for approval and inclusion within the budget.
- A communication overview plan has been developed with Oneida Recreation Complex which includes project information and is available to the community.
- The CDC Approval Package is complete:
 - ◊ School Board has approved the package.
 - ◊ OBC has approved the project.
- ONHS and General Manager continue to develop and implement various communication efforts seeking community input before presentation to GTC.
