MINUTES:

Attorney Meghan MacKelly appeared by phone on behalf of Creditor, Mariner Finance, LLC. Debtor Susan Danforth appeared in person. Parties could not come to an agreement on a weekly garnishment amount, so the Court ordered \$75.00 per week be garnished from Debtor's weekly earnings plus a \$1.00 Oneida Nation Accounting Department weekly processing fee until Debtor's total debt owed is paid in full.

THE COURT FINDS:

- 1. That Debtor is an employee of the Oneida Nation,
- 2. That the Debtor is subject to the jurisdiction of the Oneida Judiciary,
- 3. That Debtor's wages are under the control of the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Department,
- 4. That a valid judgment had been docketed against Debtor in a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction in the amount of \$3,621.80,
- 5. That it is the responsibility of the Debtor and Creditor to keep a record of total payments applied to this debt. The Accounting Department shall: (a) Send to the creditor the allowable amount garnished from the employee's paycheck following each payroll period. (b) Notify the employee and creditor when the garnishments are terminated.

[X] THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS: the above creditor is awarded a court judgment. Effective April 09, 2025, the Oneida Nation Accounting Payroll Office is hereby directed to deduct from the weekly wages of the Debtor named above in the sum of \$75.00 per week. The Creditor shall file a Notice of Satisfaction with the Court when the judgment has been satisfied through wage garnishment.

Unpaid balance of judgment: \$3,621.80

Post Judgment Interest: \$118.08

Filing fee costs: \$25.00

Total amount owed by the debtor: \$3,764.88

The amount to be remitted directly to Dobberstein Law Firm, LLC until such time as said debt is paid in full.
