Project Description:

The proposed project would provide a centrally located community recreation complex which supports the social, cultural, physical, and recreational needs of the Oneida Community. The project that will address a holistic approach to providing community recreational and social programing. The facility will consist of: gymnasium, youth learning and activity components, arts and craft space, cafeteria, events areas, small locker room, storage spaces and various administrative spaces.

The project is being coordinated with CDC #13-011 Oneida Nation High School with the intention that they will share a site/campus.

The proposed project would be a building of 132,201 square feet. The site analysis for the campus determined a need for 50 to 60 acres of property.

Current Status:

- On May 14, 2025, the Business Committee approved Option #3 with the funding being CIP in incremental allocations over the next few fiscal years. The BC approved activation of a portion of the FY2025 CIP funds for the project, which allows the project to proceed into the design phase.
- Engineering is developing a Design Services Request for Proposal package.
