## **BC Resolution # 08-27-25-A Rural and Tribal Assistance Pilot Program Grant Application**

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee supports the Oneida Nation Tribal Transportation Program to apply for the Rural and Tribal and Assistance Pilot Program grant; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rural and Tribal Assistance Pilot Program aims to help applicants develop infrastructure projects to include development activities and construction; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rural and Tribal Assistance Pilot Program requires no match and will not require tribal contribution; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Nation authorizes the submission of a grant application to the Rural and Tribal Assistance Pilot Program.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Nation Tribal Chairman, Tehassi Hill, will be authorized to sign documents in connection with the Rural and Tribal Assistance Pilot Program
