Libby is a free app that connects you to your local library's digital collection. With just your library card, you can:

- Read ebooks
- Listen to audiobooks
- Browse magazines

You can stream content online or download it to enjoy offline. It's a simple way to access tons of free reading material anytime, anywhere.

Why Should I Download the Libby App?

Libby makes it easy to explore thousands of titles from the comfort of your home, without visiting the physical library. The app syncs across your devices, allowing you to customize your reading experience and enjoy your borrowed items anytime, anywhere.

In Libby, click on “Add Library” to get started finding your library and sign in with your InfoSoup library card.

When adding your library, search for the “Oneida” or “Green Earth”. They will be under the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium.

When prompted, type in your Card Number. This will be the number on the back of your infosoup library card. Then, type in your PIN number. If you haven't changed it, it should be your birthdate, typed as MMDDYY.

This should change your home page to say, "Wisconsin's Digital Library." This means you are all signed in and ready to borrow.

Borrow Books

Your selection will vary based on your library, since each library chooses what titles and formats to offer in Libby. Click the Search icon (🔍) and type what you're looking for in the Search Bar to see if your library has it.

Click "Place Hold" or "Borrow" when you've found what you want. There will be a second "Place Hold" or "Borrow" question. This is Libby's way of asking, "Are you sure?"

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf. You'll also find your magazine subscriptions and kept magazine issues on the Magazine Rack on your Shelf.
